King Cetshwayo District Municipality (KCDM) invites tenders from service providers registered with Central Suppliers Database for Middledrift bulk augmentation: civil, building, mechanical & electrical works for 10ml/day expansion, and existing works refurbishment to the middle-drift water treatment works

Interested parties must collect tender documents from the **SCM Unit at Prince Mangosuthu Buthelezi House, Corner of Krugerrand & Barbados Bay Road, CBD, Richards Bay**. A compulsory non-refundable tender deposit fee (in line with approved tariff of council as per the tender value) of **R53 000.00** is payable for this tender. Payments must be made at the King Cetshwayo District Municipality cashier offices (Pay-Hall) in Richards Bay or via EFT to (First National Bank, King Cetshwayo District Municipality, Acc. 62943444125, Bank code 210554), **Ref. The King Cetshwayo District Municipality will strive to achieve targeted procurement in accordance with Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act Regulation 2022. **The Tenderer, who should also be the lead, should have a CIDB contractor grading of 8 CE or higher AND for the Specialist Mechanical and Electrical installer (Sub-contractor / JV Partner) an 8 ME or higher CIDB contractor grading is required. Both 8CE and 8ME are therefore required.** The tender that fails to meet the stipulated criteria will be regarded as non-responsive.

Any tender submitted by a person(s) who is in the service of the state or if that person(s) is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state or who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the Municipality shall not be considered in terms of regulation 44 of the Municipal Supply Chain Regulations. Only suppliers who are registered on Central Supplier Data Base (CSD, visit the CSD website at www.csd.gov.za) can apply for these tenders. All suppliers applying for these tenders must register on the Municipal database

Prospective service providers are required to ensure full completion and correctness of information when responding to MBD 4 and all other required declarations in the document. The municipality reserves the right to validate the correctness of the declarations through various databases inclusive of the Central Supplier Database (CSD). Failure to fully complete and/or provision of incorrect information in the declaration will be regarded by the employer as a non-responsive tender.

Completed tenders in sealed envelopes **BEARING THE TENDER NUMBER** must be deposited in the **Municipality's tender box in the foyer of Prince Mangosuthu Buthelezi House, Corner of Krugerrand & Barbados Bay Road, CBD, Richards Bay on or before closing date.** Tenders will be opened in public. Tenders received after the due date and time will not be considered.

It will be the tenderer's responsibility to check the document on receipt for completeness and to notify the employer of any discrepancies or omissions. It is the tenderer's responsibility to provide all the data and information requested in the form required, failure to do so may be regarded by the employer as a non-responsive tender. Submissions may only be done on documentation supplied by the Municipality.
