DETAILED SPECIFICATION

PROVISION OF UNINTERRUPTED POWER SUPPLY (UPS) ASSESSMENT FOR BATTERY OR UPS REPLACEMENT FOR THE PORTS REGULATOR OF SOUTH AFRICA

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 Ports Regulator of South Africa (PRSA) is a Schedule 3A public entity in terms of the Public Finance Management Act, 1 of 1999 (PFMA). Port Regulator South Africa must fully comply with all the requirements of the PFMA.
- 1.2 The Ports Regulator is the independent National Regulator for the South African ports, governed by the National Ports Act, 2005 (Act No. 12 of 2005). In terms of section 30 (1) and (2) of the National Ports Act, the main function of the Regulator is to:
- Exercise economic regulation for the ports system in line with government's strategic objectives.
 - Promote equity of access of ports and facilities and service provider by ports.
 - Monitor the activities of the National Ports Authority to ensure that it performs its functions in accordance with the act; and
 - Hear appeals and complaints contemplated in terms of Section 48 of the Act.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this invitation is to request suitably qualified and experienced service providers to inspect and submit quotation based on the inspection report for the maintenance of the Ports Regulator's UPS.

3. MOTIVATION

It is of vital importance for the office to have a backup power supply to keep operations running during planned and unplanned power outages and minimise the likelihood of data loss and hardware damage due to abrupt power outage and spikes.

4. SCOPE OF WORK

The Ports Regulator's UPS must be inspected onsite. Service provider to determine whether batteries need to be changed or replace the entire UPS. The details of the UPS are as follows:

5. EVALUATION CRITERIA

5.1 SCM Administrative

- The service provider must submit proof of registration on CSD (Central Supplier Database).
