#### 3 PROPOSAL SUBMISSION


Transnet has implemented a new electronic tender submission system, the e-Tender Submission Portal, in line with the overall Transnet digitalization strategy where suppliers can view advertised tenders, register their information, log their intent to respond to bids and upload their bid proposals/responses on to the system.

#### 4 RFP INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1 Please sign documents [sign, stamp and date the bottom of each page] before uploading them on the system. The person or persons signing the submission must be legally authorised by the respondent to do so.
- 4.2 All returnable documents tabled in the Proposal Form [Section 5] must be returned with proposals.







4.4 Any additional conditions must be embodied in an accompanying letter. Subject only to clause 15

[Alterations made by the Respondent to Bid Prices] of the General Bid Conditions, paragraph 11 below (Legal Review) and Section 6 of the RFP, alterations, additions or deletions must not be made by the Respondent to the actual RFP documents.

#### 5 JOINT VENTURES OR CONSORTIUMS

Respondents who would wish to respond to this RFP as a Joint Venture [JV] or consortium with B-BBEE entities, must state their intention to do so in their RFP submission. Such Respondents must also submit a signed JV or consortium agreement between the parties clearly stating the percentage [%] split of business and the associated responsibilities of each party. If at the time of the bid submission such a JV or consortium agreement has not been concluded, the partners must submit confirmation in writing of their intention to enter into a JV or consortium agreement should they be awarded business by Transnet through this RFP process. This written confirmation must clearly indicate the percentage [%] split of business and the responsibilities of each party. In such cases, award of business will only take place once a signed copy of a JV or consortium agreement is submitted to Transnet.

• Respondents are to note that for the purpose of Evaluation, a JV will be evaluated based on one consolidated B-BBEE score card (a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level verification certificate) Preference points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the specific goals requirements in accordance with the table indicated in Table 3.2 of the specific goals Claim Form.

#### **6** COMMUNICATION

- 6.1 For specific queries relating to this RFP, an RFP Clarification Request Form should be submitted onto the system and to [Kgaugelo.Makgate@transnet.net] before 12:00 pm on 15 November 2024, substantially in the form set out in Section 8 hereto. In the interest of fairness and transparency, Transnet's response to such a query will be published on the e-tender portal and Transnet website.

- 6.3 Respondents are to note that changes to its submission will not be considered after the closing date.
- 6.4 It is prohibited for Respondents to attempt, either directly or indirectly, to canvass any officer or employee of Transnet in respect of this RFP between the closing date and the date of the award of the business.
- 6.5 Respondents found to be in collusion with one another will be automatically disqualified and restricted from doing business with organs of state for a specified period.
- 6.6 Transnet will publish the outcome of this RFP in the National Treasury e-tender portal and Transnet website with 10 days after the award has been finalised. Respondents are required to check the National Treasury e-tender Portal and Transnet website for the results of the tender process. All unsuccessful bidders have a right to request Transnet to furnish individual reasons for their bid not being successful. This requested must be directed to the contact person stated in the SBD 1 form

#### **7 CONFIDENTIALITY**

All information related to this RFP is to be treated with strict confidence. In this regard Respondents are required to certify that they have acquainted themselves with the Non-Disclosure Agreement. All information related to a subsequent contract, both during and after completion thereof, will be treated with strict confidence. Should the need however arise to divulge any information related to this RFP or the subsequent contract, written approval must be obtained from Transnet.



#### 8 COMPLIANCE



The successful Respondent [hereinafter referred to as the **Service provider**] shall be in full and complete compliance with any and all applicable laws and regulations.

#### 9 EMPLOYMENT EQUITY ACT

Respondents must comply with the requirements of the Employment Equity Act 55 of 1998 applicable to it including (but not limited to) Section 53 of the Employment Equity Act.

#### 10 DISCLAIMERS

Respondents are hereby advised that Transnet is not committed to any course of action as a result of its issuance of this RFP and/or its receipt of Proposals. In particular, please note that Transnet reserves the right to:

- 10.1 modify the RFP's Goods/Services and request Respondents to re-bid on any such changes;
- 10.2 reject any Proposal which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein;
- 10.3 disqualify Proposals submitted after the stated submission deadline [closing date];
- 10.4 award a contract in connection with this Proposal at any time after the RFP's closing date;
- 10.5 award a contract for only a portion of the proposed Goods/Services which are reflected in the scope of this RFP;
- split the award of the contract between more than one Supplier/Service provider, should it at Transnet's discretion be more advantageous in terms of, amongst others, cost or developmental considerations;
- 10.7 cancel the bid process;
- 10.8 validate any information submitted by Respondents in response to this bid. This would include, but is not limited to, requesting the Respondents to provide supporting evidence. By submitting a bid, Respondents hereby irrevocably grant the necessary consent to Transnet to do so;
- 10.9 request audited financial statements or other documentation for the purposes of a due diligence exercise;
- 10.10 not accept any changes or purported changes by the Respondent to the bid rates after the closing date and/or after the award of the business, unless the contract specifically provided for it;
- 10.11 to cancel the contract and/request that National Treasury place the Respondent on its Database of Restricted Suppliers for a period not exceeding 10 years, on the basis that a contract was awarded on the strength of incorrect information furnished by the Respondent or on any other basis recognised in law;
- 10.12 to award the business to the next ranked bidder, provided that he/she is still prepared to provide the required Goods at the quoted price, should the preferred bidder fail to sign or commence with the contract within a reasonable period after being requested to do so. Under such circumstances, the validity of the bids of the next ranked bidder(s) will be deemed to remain valid, irrespective of whether the outcome of the tender has been published the outcome of the bid process on the National Treasury e-tender Portal and Transnet website. Bidders may therefore be requested to advise whether they would still be prepared to provide the required Goods at their quoted price.

Note that Transnet will not reimburse any Respondent for any preparatory costs or other work performed in connection with its Proposal, whether or not the Respondent is awarded a contract.

#### 11 LEGAL REVIEW

A Proposal submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business. A material deviation from the Standard terms or conditions could result in disqualification.



#### 12 SECURITY CLEARANCE



Acceptance of this bid could be subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent, its personnel providing the Goods/Services and its subcontractor(s) must obtain security clearance from the appropriate authorities to the level of **CONFIDENTIAL/ SECRET/TOP SECRET**. Obtaining the required clearance is the responsibility of the Successful Respondent. Acceptance of the bid is also subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent will implement all such security measures as the safe performance of the contract may require.

#### 13 NATIONAL TREASURY'S CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE

Respondents are required to self-register on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which has been established to centrally administer supplier information for all organs of state and facilitate the verification of certain key supplier information. Respondents must register on the CSD prior to submitting their bids. Business may not be awarded to a Respondent who has failed to register on the CSD. Only foreign suppliers with no local registered entity need not register on the CSD.

#### 14 TAX COMPLIANCE

Respondents must be compliant when submitting a proposal to Transnet and remain compliant for the entire contract term with all applicable tax legislation, including but not limited to the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962) and Value Added Tax Act, 1991 (Act No. 89 of 1991).

It is a condition of this bid that the tax matters of the successful Respondents be in order, or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the Respondents tax obligations.

The Tax Compliance status requirements are also applicable to foreign Respondents/ individuals who wish to submit bids.

#### **SECTION 3: BACKGROUND, OVERVIEW AND SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS**

#### 1 BACKGROUND

The Voice Recorder System is used to govern train operating communications and ensures all safety processes and procedures are being adhered to and is a requirement from the RSR (SANS 3000-2-4). These recorded voice logs are especially important during investigations wherein an incident (train collision, train derailment) has occurred, in such situations a centralized solution is required in order to mitigate the possibility of human tampering. The system being used currently was installed in 2012 and was designed to record analogue and digital communication.

The current voice recording system is obsolete with no spares available for maintenance. The components of which the solution is comprised have become outdated, making support and maintenance highly complex. Various challenges pertaining the current voice recorder systems, ranges from obsolescence to inability to support current and future train operation recording requirements and are summarised below:

- The voice recorder infrastructure has met its end of life and is no longer supported by the OEM.
- The voice recorders do not support centralization of voice log files, which creates discrepancies when incidents occur, and voice logs have disappeared.
- The voice recorder infrastructure/material can only be sourced from one supplier. It is near impossible to buy spares as a confinement is sought and due to high prices, the confined voice logger modules cannot be procured.
- The inability to support the VOIP applications as a new and future requirement based on the digital backbone network that is currently being installed.

Additionally, the Railway Safety Regulator (RSR) requires TFR to record all voice communication/authorization between the train control officer (TCO) and the train drivers at Train Control Centres (TCC) as per regulation SANS 3000-2-4. The intended upgrade is sought to curtail the challenges stipulated above and also to bring in additional opportunities to facilitate technology and strategic requirements in order for TFR Rail Network to have more control on the deployed technologies and associated development / evolution stages.

#### 2 EXECUTIVE OVERVIEW

Whereas Transnet is seeking a partner to provide solutions for its voice recorder systems and associated accessories intended for the upgrade of currently installed system across Transnet Freight Rail's Centralised Train Controls nationally, it also seeks to improve its current processes for providing these Goods/Services to its end user community throughout its locations.

The selected Service provider must share in the mission and business objectives of Transnet. These mutual goals will be met by meeting contractual requirements and new challenges in an environment of teamwork, joint participation, flexibility, innovation and open communications. In this spirit of partnership, Transnet and its Supplier/Service provider(s) will study the current ways they do business to enhance current practices and support processes and systems. Such a partnership will allow Transnet to reach higher levels of quality, service and profitability.

Specifically, Transnet seeks to benefit from this partnership in the following ways:

**2.1** Transnet must receive reduced cost of acquisition and improved service benefits resulting from the Supplier/Service provider's economies of scale and streamlined service processes.



**2.2** Transnet must achieve appropriate availability that meets user needs while reducing costs for both Transnet and the chosen Supplier/Service provider(s).



- **2.3** Transnet must receive proactive improvements from the Supplier/Service provider with respect to supply/provision of Goods/Services and related processes.
- **2.4** Transnet's overall competitive advantage must be strengthened by the chosen Supplier/Service provider's leading edge technology and service delivery systems.
- **2.5** Transnet end users must be able to rely on the chosen Supplier/Service provider's personnel for service enquiries, recommendations and substitutions.
- **2.6** Transnet must reduce costs by streamlining its acquisition of Goods/Services, including managed service processes on a Group basis.

#### 3 SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

#### Introduction

The voice logger equipment offered must comply with Transnet specifications as follows:



- All equipment supplied must conform to the technical specifications BBH2148.

#### Scope of Work

This section defines work and deliverables necessary to fulfil the project objective

- a) The supply, installation, configuration, integration, and maintenance of a countrywide voice recording system for TFR to record all voice communication/authorization between the train control officer (TCO) and the train drivers as per regulation SANS 3000-2-4.
- b) The maintenance support must include hardware and software support. The maintenance will kick in after commissioning and Quality assurance acceptance. Maintenance and support will for sixty (60) months. Where the bidder is not the OEM, such bidder must arrange all support and maintenance between the voice recording system OEM and Transnet.
- c) The bidder will be responsible for training that is required by TFR Telecommunications department.
- d) Except where otherwise stated in this scope of work, all equipment, installation must conform to the latest recommendations of the SANS, ISO, IEEE, SABS, ICASA and CENELEC standards related to the voice recording system.
- e) All standards and requirements in this document must be adhered to and any deviations must first be discussed with the TFR Telecommunications department. Such proposed deviations can only be deemed accepted by TFR when confirmed in writing and duly signed by the Chief Engineer of Telecommunications.
- f) Tenderers must certify that they are familiar with all OEM's and devices used.

#### **Hardware & System Documentation**



- a) The system will be developed to require minimal maintenance. All maintenance procedures will be fully documented.
- b) The system and its sub-systems shall be fully documented in English UK.
- c) Technical documentation shall contain all the relevant information of the system interfaces and include a full description of the hardware, protocols and message contents used on all interfaces.

#### **Software Documentation & Control**

#### **Service Level Agreement**

Transnet requires a service level agreement with the contractor. This agreement shall focus on the maintenance and support (hardware and software), guarantee and warranty policies related to the components that make up the voice recording software.



#### **Training**



- a) During commissioning of the system, the contractor shall provide:
  - > Practical training in all aspects of system operation to a core group of 40 TFR administrative/operating/Transnet Academy personnel.
  - > Theoretical and practical training in all aspects of first line system maintenance to a core group of technicians and Transnet Academy training specialists.
  - > Comprehensive theoretical and practical training covering the entire system to a group of technicians, School of Rail training specialists and/or technologists and/or engineers from Rail Network Telecommunications and Technology Management.
- b) Additional courses and refresher training covering most of the above aspects will be required periodically to train new staff. This will be made available by the contractor on request from Transnet Freight Rail at market related cost.
- c) The contractor should develop and provide a training programme for three levels of training (shown below) and should stipulate the duration of training required for each level. The training programme should show the learning modules and outcomes for each level of training.

#### i. Voice Logger Operator Training

> This will consist of a short training session, as the voice logger user interface will be almost identical to the current voice logger user interface.

#### ii. Technician Training

> Technicians will receive voice logger operator training and will be trained to set up a new Voice recorder and will be issued with operator and installation manuals.

#### iii. Engineering Training

> Engineering personnel will receive Technician training and will be trained to configure and troubleshoot the voice logger software and hardware, this includes access control i.e. add users and privileges, access to log and database files.

#### **Period of performance evaluation**

> The awarded contractor will be required to offer support for all the components including software of the voice recording software for a period of the contract on activation of the service level agreement.



#### **REQUIREMENTS**

➤ The equipment offered must comply with the BBH2148 specifications.

#### 2.3 Deliverables:

After installation of all sites (as per specification and quantities specified in Table: 1) all Voice logger must be recording and commissioned within the specified time.





- 1.6 The purchaser reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before a bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the purchaser.

## 2. **DEFINITIONS**

- (a) "all applicable taxes" includes value-added tax, pay as you earn, income tax, unemployment insurance fund contributions and skills development levies;
- (b) **"B-BBEE"** means broad-based black economic empowerment as defined in section 1 of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (c) "B-BBEE status level of contributor" means the B-BBEE status received by a measured entity based

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on its overall performance using the relevant scorecard contained in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;

- (d) "Ownership" means 51% black ownership
- (e) "bid" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the supply/provision of services, works or goods, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
- (f) "Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act" means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (g) **"EME"** means an Exempted Micro Enterprise as defines by Codes of Good Practice under section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (h) **"functionality"** means the ability of a bidder to provide goods or services in accordance with specification as set out in the bid documents
- (i) "Price" includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts.
- (j) "Proof of B-BBEE Status Level of Contributor"
  - i) the B-BBBEE status level certificate issued by an authorised body or person;
  - ii) a sworn affidavit as prescribed by the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice; or
  - iii) any other requirement prescribed in terms of the B-BBEE Act.
- (k) "QSE" means a Qualifying Small Enterprise as defines by Codes of Good Practice under section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (I) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties.
- (m) **"Specific goals"** means targeted advancement areas or categories of persons or groups either previously disadvantaged or falling within the scope of the Reconstruction and Development Programme identified by Transnet to be given preference in allocation of procurement contracts in line with section 2(1) of the PPPFA.

#### 3. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

## 3.1 THE 80/20 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

- 4.3 A trust, consortium or joint venture (including unincorporated consortia and joint ventures) must submit a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level verification certificate for every separate bid.
- 4.4 Tertiary Institutions and Public Entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialized scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.

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- A person will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the bid documents that such a bidder intends sub-contracting more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the points that such a bidder qualifies for, unless the intended sub-contractor is an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.
