1. BACKGROUND

The South African Diamond and Precious Metals Regulator (SADPMR) is a Schedule 3A PFMA entity established in terms of section 3 of the Diamonds Act, 1986 (Act No.56 of 1986), as amended (Diamonds Act as amended). The SADPMR derives its mandate from the Diamonds Act and the Precious Metals Act, 2005 (Act No. 37 of 2005).

The SADPMR is in the process of procuring new furniture and there is need for the old furniture to be moved into a storage facility.

2. SCOPE

The SADPMR seeks to appoint a service provider to provide the storage facility for office assets while disposal/auction of old furniture is being undertaken. The furniture will be moved into the appointed service provider facility in three (3) phases.

2.1 Service to be rendered
