1. CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

Appointment of External Technical Experts for Supply Chain Management (SCM) Bid Evaluation Committee

The Takeover Regulation Panel (the Panel) hereby invites suitably qualified and experienced individuals to submit EOI for inclusion on a database of external technical experts to assist in SCM bid processes.

2. ABOUT THE PANEL

The Takeover Regulation Panel (the Panel) is established as a juristic person in terms of section 196 of the Companies Act No 71 of 2008 (the Act). The Panel reports to the Minister of the Department of Trade, Industry and Competition (the dtic). It functions as an organ of state within the public administration but as an institution outside the public service.

The Panel is listed as a Schedule 3A public entity in the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act 1 of 1999).

3. PURPOSE OF THE BID

The purpose of this EOI is to establish a pool of independent external experts who may be appointed on an ad hoc basis to serve on Bid Evaluation Committees (BEC), and to provide technical expertise during the evaluation of bids where specialised knowledge is required.

4. SCOPE OF WORK

External experts may be required to:

- 4.1. Participate in BEC meetings
- 4.2. Provide technical input in drafting specifications and evaluating bids
- 4.3. Evaluate functionality and technical compliance of bids
- 4.4. Compile or contribute to evaluation reports
- 4.5. Advise on technical risks and considerations
- 4.6. Sign confidentiality and declaration of interest forms
- 4.7. Adhere to all SCM prescripts and ethical standards

5. FIELDS OF EXPERTISE REQUIRED

The Panel invites applications from experts in, but not limited to:

- 5.1. Legal and regulatory compliance
- 5.2. Supply Chain Management and Public Procurement
- 5.3. Information Technology and Cybersecurity
- 5.4. Finance, audit, and risk management

- 5.5. Corporate governance
- 5.6. Any other specialised technical field relevant to the Panel

6. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must:

- 6.1. Possess a relevant qualification (NQF Level 7 or higher will be advantageous)
- 6.2. Have at least 5–10 years' relevant experience
- 6.3. Demonstrate experience in technical evaluation, advisory, or procurement processes
- 6.4. Be independent and free from conflicts of interest
- 6.5. Be registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD)

7. TERM OF APPOINTMENT

Successful applicants will be appointed to the Panel's database for a period of three (3) years. Appointment to the database does not guarantee allocation of work.

8. REMUNERATION

Appointed experts will be remunerated in accordance with the Panel's approved fee structure or applicable National Treasury guidelines for external advisors/consultants. Payment will be made only for services rendered.

² Joint venture or Consortium means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skill and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract.

PREFERENCE POINTS CLAIM FORM IN TERMS OF THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS 2022

This preference form must form part of all tenders invited. It contains general information and serves as a claim form for preference points for specific goals.

NB: BEFORE COMPLETING THIS FORM, TENDERERS MUST STUDY THE GENERAL CONDITIONS, DEFINITIONS AND DIRECTIVES APPLICABLE IN RESPECT OF THE TENDER AND PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS, 2022

1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1.1. The following preference points systems apply to invitations to tender:
 - 1.1.1. the 80/20 system for requirements with a Rand value of up to R50 000 000 (all applicable taxes included); and
 - 1.1.2. the 90/10 system for requirements with a Rand value above R50 000 000 (all applicable taxes included).

1.2. To be completed by the Organ of State

The applicable preference point system for this tender is the **80/20** preference point system.

- 1.3. Points for this tender (even in the case of a tender for income-generating contracts) shall be awarded for:

- 1.3.1. Price; and
- 1.3.2. Specific Goals.

1.4. To be completed by the Organ of State:

The maximum points for this tender are as follows:

- 1.5. Failure on the part of a tenderer to submit proof or documentation required in terms of this tender to claim points for specific goals with the tender will be interpreted to mean that preference points for specific goals are not claimed.

- 1.6. The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim regarding preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

2. DEFINITIONS

- 2.1. **“tender”** means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation;
- 2.2. **“price”** means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts
- 2.3. **“rand value”** means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- 2.4. **“tender for income-generating contracts”** means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and
- 2.5. **“the Act”** means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

3. FORMULA FOR PROCUREMENT OF GOODS AND SERVICES

3.1. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

3.1.1. THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

80/20:

Where:

P_s = Points scored for price of bid under consideration

P_t = Price of bid under consideration

P_{\min} = Price of lowest acceptable bid

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR B-BBEE STATUS LEVEL OF CONTRIBUTOR

- 4.1. In terms of Regulation 6 (2) and 7 (2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, reference points must be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:
