Note 02: Company registration

A proof of company registration in the form of a copy from the Companies and Intellectual Property Commissions (CIPC) shall be attached including a copy of a certificate for proof of shareholding. Failure to attach the certificate shall warrant an automatic elimination of the tender from any further evaluation.

Note 03: Delegation of Authority

In the case of a Company, a delegation of Authority signed by the Consulting Firm's Board of Directors nominating a Team Leader as a delegated and authorized Signatory must be attached.
