- 5.6 Respondents found to be in collusion with one another will be automatically disqualified and restricted from doing business with organs of state for a specified period.

- 9.2 award a contract in connection with this Proposal at any time after the RFP's closing date;
- 9.3 award a contract for only a portion of the proposed Goods/Services which are reflected in the scope of this RFP;
- 9.4 split the award of the contract between more than one Supplier/Service provider, as may be explicitly articulated in the conditions or objective criteria to this RFP;
- 9.5 cancel the bid process;

#### **SECTION 3: BACKGROUND, OVERVIEW AND SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS**

#### 1 BACKGROUND

Brief description of the goods or service required and the reason(s) for the proposed acquisition:

The Transnet Rail Infrastructure Manager (TRIM) requires a service provider with proven competence and experience to conduct random drug testing and provide education and training on drug abuse at Transnet Rail Infrastructure Manager on an as and when required basis for a period of three years. The service provider must have the capability to provide services nationally at TRIM Depots and sub-depots in Security, Support function, Centralised Traffic Control (CTC), Network services planning and Operation (SP&O) to ensure that all TRIM employees are reached.

The Transnet Rail Infrastructure Manager reserves the right to test TRIM employees, contractor employees, Train Operating Company's employees, visitors on an as and when required basis.

The Drug testing must be conducted through a screening test first, where nonnegative results is detected, will subject an employee to a laboratory confirmatory test to establish the concentration level of a substance used.

#### 2 EXECUTIVE OVERVIEW

Whereas Transnet is seeking a partner(s) to provide solutions for its provision of random drug, post incident testing and awareness training within Transnet Rail Infrastructure manager nationally for a period of three (3) years, nationally on an as and when required basis, it also seeks to improve its current processes for providing these Goods/Services to its end user community throughout its locations.

The selected Service provider must share in the mission and business objectives of Transnet. These mutual goals will be met by meeting contractual requirements and new challenges in an environment of teamwork, joint participation, flexibility, innovation and open communications. In this spirit of partnership, Transnet and its Service provider(s) will study the current ways they do business to enhance current practices and support processes and systems. Such a partnership will allow Transnet to reach higher levels of quality, service and profitability.

Specifically, Transnet seeks to benefit from this partnership in the following ways:

- 2.1 Transnet must receive reduced cost of acquisition and improved service benefits resulting from the Service provider's economies of scale and streamlined service processes.
- 2.2 Transnet must achieve appropriate availability that meets user needs while reducing costs for both Transnet and the chosen Service provider.
- 2.3 Transnet must receive proactive improvements from the Service provider with respect to supply/provision of Services and related processes.

- 3.4 The service provider shall have the capability to provide random drug, post incident testing and training services nationally to all TRIM depots and sub-depots as per Table A Annexure E of TRIM scope of work.


