

1. Human resources - Key personnel

The bidder must provide proof of the workforce to execute the project by attaching their CV's, Certified Copies of their qualification Certificates and Certified ID's that are not older than six (6) months on the closing date of tender advert.

A company's project organogram should be attached which reflects the key personnel to be permanently assigned to the project with their relevant experience in the built environment under the below mentioned key site staff members required. The key personnel should be employees of the company if not, an undertaking should be attached from the person that he/she will be involved for the duration of the project and to be permanently assigned to the project on a full time basis.

Please Note: The below will be evaluated as a cluster, any omission of any individual below will result in a zero score.

a). For a bidder to be allocated 5 points, the bidder should have the following:

- Contract Manager – Construction Project Manager registered as professional with SACPCMP respectively with more than 10 years of experience (post qualification).
- Site Agent with building qualification from a minimum of National diploma with more than 10 years of experience (post qualification)
- Safety Officer with relevant built environment qualification must be registered with SACPCMP as a professional or candidate.

b). For a bidder to be allocated 4 points, the bidder should have the following:

- Contract Manager – Construction Project Manager registered as professional with SACPCMP respectively with more than 8 years upto and including 10 years of experience (post qualification).
- Site Agent with building qualification from a minimum of National diploma with more than 8 years upto and including 10 years of experience (post qualification)
- Safety Officer with relevant built environment qualification must be registered with SACPCMP as a professional or candidate.

c). For a bidder to be allocated 3 points, the bidder should have the following:

- Contract Manager – Construction Project Manager registered as professional with SACPCMP respectively with more than 6 years upto and including 8 years of experience (post qualification).
- Site Agent with building qualification from a minimum of National diploma with more than 6 years upto and including 8 years of experience (post qualification)
- Safety Officer with relevant built environment qualification must be registered with SACPCMP as a professional or candidate.

d). For a bidder to be allocated 2 points, the bidder should have the following:

- Contract Manager – Construction Project Manager registered as professional with SACPCMP respectively with more than 4 years upto and including 6 years to experience (post qualification).
- Site Agent with building qualification from a minimum of National diploma with more than 4 years upto and including 6 years of experience (post qualification)
- Safety Officer with relevant built environment qualification must be registered with SACPCMP as a professional or candidate.

e). For a bidder to be allocated 1 point, the bidder should have the following:

- Contract Manager – Construction Project Manager registered as professional with SACPCMP respectively with more than 1 year upto and including 4 years of experience (post qualification).

Project Completed – Work Experience</p> <p>The Tenderer must provide an appointment letter and Practical or First delivery Completion Certificates on the referenced projects of their company's construction experience specifically with contactable reference. Comparable / relevant (similar in nature & value) general building or civil projects ranging from R 13 million and above projects in dolomitic areas and the projects must be indicated as such, i.e. which were successfully completed by the company within the past ten (10) years. This project requires the incorporation of high quality and dolomitic experience of both the contractor and the key personnel on site because it deals with sensitive works e.g. possible sink holes and special requirements on how the piping and trenches should be done. The project require specialist materials, processes and methodology on the pipe installations with a life cycle in excess of 50 years or more. More importantly if the
