Submit the company organogram. The certificates submitted for this item needs to be for the same resources as reflected in the Company Organogram

Note: All Copies of Legible Certificates must be certified should not be older than 3 months on the submission date.

Tenders which do not meet Eskom's mandatory requirements will not be evaluated further for non-negotiable functionality threshold.

All responsive tenders will be evaluated further for functionality threshold
