Description of service required

APPOINTMENT OF SERVICE PROVIDER FOR THE PROVISION OF VEHICLE TRACKING SERVICES ON THE PRESIDENCY'S VEHICLES FOR PERIOD OF THREE(3) YEARS

1. Scope of Work

- a. The Presidency fleet is currently comprise of 9 vehicles that need tracking services.
- b. The bidder will be expected to supply and install the units and sign a three-year contract.
- c. Supply and install all the units within 14 days after signing the contract. The bidder will be required to provide thorough training and support to The Presidency Transport Office.
- d. Fleet Management reports

1.1 Services required:

- Active tracking and monitoring of vehicles 24 hours, seven days a week.
- Knowing where vehicles are at any given time (live web-tracking),
- Track and recovery when stolen.
- Travel playback for investigations at least 90 days.
- The contract must accommodate add/removal/transfer of tracking devices during the contract period.
- The tracking device cost must be amortized over the contract period and form part of the monthly service fee.
- Replace damaged, maintain, and upgrade current tracking devices and provide a report at regular interval/s (e.g., weekly/monthly reports) to always ensure functionality.
- Liaise with The Presidency Transport Office during the roll-out on all project activities and provide progress reports during the implementation phase.
- De-installation of the system will be at the service provider's expense in case of written-off vehicles, disposal, and contract termination within seven days.
- Guarantee support and business continuity.
- Price quoted should be firm and Vat inclusive for the contract duration, include annual escalations if applicable.
- Call-outs for maintenance and technical issues must be dealt with within a maximum of 48 hours of a call been logged.
- The service provider will be required to provide an accident report on The Presidency vehicles when needed.

- The supplier must submit a catalogue or operational manual of the system.
- Standard manufacturers' guarantees and warranties are to be provided for each unit.
- The Presidency reserves the right to terminate the services of specific devices if they are no longer in use, e.g., written off, stolen, or sold vehicle/s (Early termination fee may apply).
- The device must be fitted into the vehicle in a manner that does not interfere with vehicle manufacturer warranties, is un-detachable, and is difficult to temper.
- The device must allow unlimited tests and searches for GSM device operation.
- The device must have a backup battery to retain data in the event of a disconnection of power and monitor the battery in real-time.
- The device must allow for remote software upgrades.
- The device must be able to send e-mail alerts on any of the configured violations.
- Signal-jamming detection
- Driver-behavior monitoring
- Vehicle logbook
- Journey and Route management
- Fuel management and administration
- Panic buttons (if standard as part of the solution).
- Impact sensors that give indications of a crash as and when they happen.

1.2 Application specification:

- Web-based fleet management software.
- Location-based services.
- Configurable SMS or e-mail notification.
- High-risk area and border proximity notification.
- Ignition on/off and battery tampering notification.
- Trip playback for investigations at least 90 days.
- Any other enhanced security features.
- Provide Web-based Fleet management software and software updates.

N.B The service provider will be required to provide tracking device installation certificate for all devices installed.

3. EVALUATION PROCESS

A three (3) phase approach will be followed during the evaluation phase. All proposals received will be evaluated in accordance with the **80/20-point** system as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Regulation, 2022.

3.1 Phase 1: Mandatory and Administrative requirements

a) Mandatory requirements

- I. Independent Communication Authority of South Africa (ICASA) approval of the devices proposed. Bidder must attach a valid certificate.
- II. PSIRA certificate from the contracted (sub-contracted) recovery team/company. Bidder must attach a valid certificate.
- III. Motor Vehicle Security Association of South Africa (VESA/VSS) certificate. Bidder must attach a valid certificate.

b) Administrative requirements

- I. Valid Tax Pin Number from SARS
- II. Proof of Central supplier database registration
- III. Completed and signed Bidders' disclosure form (SBD 4)
- IV. Completed and signed Applicable Price Schedule (Annexure A)

3.2 Phase 2: Functionality
