EVALUATION

- Tenders must provide proof of COIDA (Letter of good standing with the Workers Compensation Commissioner or proof of application) with the Department of Labour, FEM or RMA

Price and Preference

This phase is based on the 80/20 Preference point system in terms of the preferential procurement Policy Framework Act, with 80 points allocated for price and 20 points for B-BBEE recognition. ACSA will only accept the DTI criteria as proof of B-BBEE status.
