REQUEST FOR QUOTATIONS FOR AUDIT TOWARDS OBTAINING A HUMAN RESOURCES CERTIFICATION AGAINST THE HUMAN RESOURCES STANDARDS THAT ARE PUBLISHED BY THE SABPP.



1. Purpose

- 1.1. The Railway Safety Regulator (RSR) requires the services of suitable service provider to assist with the audit towards obtaining a Human Resources Certification against the Human Resources Standards that are published by the SABPP.

Specifications are as follows:

- 1. Conduct pre-certification Audit on all relevant standards and identify gaps.
- 2. Make recommendations to address the identified gaps.
- Create alignment with the South Africa Board of Personnel Practitioners (SABPP) standards.
- 4. Conduct the audit in line with the SABPP Standards.
- 5. Provide workshops and / or training on all SABPP Standards prior to the Audit

Failure to submit valid documents listed above (**No - 4.5, 4.6, 4.7, 4.8, 4.9, 4.10**) for proof of claim specific goals as stipulated in Section 6 below will lead to the service provider not being awarded points for specific goal.

5. Mandatory

5.1 Service provider to submit an up-to-date accreditation status with SABPP.

Failure to provide this will result in a disqualification.

Service Providers must attain a minimum threshold of 70 points or more to be considered for evaluation on price and specific goals.

Failure to attain the set minimum threshold will result in a disqualification.

7. Evaluation 80/20 Preference Point System

7.1. The price quotations will be evaluated in accordance with the pre-scripts of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA) and its regulations, in particular Preference Procurement Regulation 2022 which Page 5 of 9



stipulate 80/20 preference point system for acquisition of goods or services with Rand value equal to or below R50 million (inclusive of all applicable tax).

- 7.2. A maximum of 80 points for price and 20 points for the specific goal specified on the request for quotation may be awarded to a Service Provider.
- 7.3. Points for the specific goal will be awarded as specified on the table below:
