


Procurement process briefing (Overview)

- ☐ The tender was advertised on the Transnet Rail Engineering website/portal, CIDB and National Treasury.
- ☐ The RFQ closing date and time is the **18 March 2024** at **10:00am** promptly. Please ensure that you abide with the deadline. Late submissions will be disqualified.
- □ For bid submission. (Log on to the Transnet e-Tender Submission Portal platform website (https://transnetetenders.azurewebsites.net/) Refer to page 4 on the RFP- Tender Submission
- □ Bidders are requested to remain for the entire duration of the briefing session as important information pertaining to the RFQ will be presented

Step 1: Test for Administrative Responsiveness

Whether the Bid has been lodged on time

The test for administrative responsiveness will include the following:

Administrative responsiveness check

- Whether the Bid has been lodged on time
- Whether the Bid contains a priced offer
- Whether the Bid materially complies with the scope and/or specification given
- Whether any general pre-qualification criteria set by Transnet have been met

NB: The test for administrative responsiveness [step one] must be passed for a Respondent's proposal to progress to step two for further pre-qualifications



Step 2: Test for Substantive Responsiveness

2.1 Substantive Responsiveness

Only those tenderers who satisfy the following eligibility criteria are eligible to submit tenders:

1. Eligibility with regards to attendance at the compulsory clarification meeting:
An authorised representative of the tendering entity or a representative of a tendering entity that intends to form a Joint Venture (JV) must attend the compulsory clarification meeting in terms C2





Only those tenderers who satisfy the following eligibility criteria are eligible to submit tenders: Eligibility in terms of the **Construction Industry Development Board: 2CE or higher** a) Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, or are capable of being so registered prior to the evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, designation **of 2CE or higher** class of construction works, are eligible to have their tenders evaluated.

The minimum number of evaluation points for functionality is: 60 points


- ❖ Any tenderer that fails to meet the stipulated pre-qualifying criteria will be regarded as an unacceptable tender.
- ❖ The minimum threshold for technical/functionality [Step three] must be met or exceeded for a Respondent's Proposal to progress to next step evaluation.





Step 4: Price and Specific goals

- Only bidders who have met the predetermined threshold will proceed to stage 4
- Points will be allocated as follows:
- > Price (80); and
- > Specific Goals scorecard (20)





Specific Goals scorecard – (20 point)

In terms of Transnet Preferential Procurement Policy (TPPP) and Procurement Manuals, the following preference points must be awarded to a bidder who provides the relevant required evidence for claiming points:

- B-BBEE Level of contributor Level 1 or Level 2- 5 points
- EME or QSE 51% Black Owned -5 points
- Majority Company Owned by People with disabilities. 5 Points
- 30% Black Women Owned Entities 5 Points
- Non-Compliant and/or B-BBEE Level 3-8 contributors 0 points
