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1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

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TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF SERVICE PROVIDER FOR CONDUCTING NETWORK PENETRATION TESTING AND QUALITY ASSURANCE OF SYSTEM APPLICATIONS FOR THE SOUTH AFRICAN DIAMONDS AND PRECIOUS METALS REGULATOR (SADPMR).

1. BACKGROUND

The South African Diamond and Precious Metals Regulator (SADPMR) is located at Corner Bonaero Drive and Cote D Azur Avenue , Kempton Park,1622.

The environment operates on a Microsoft platform, its primary operating system or infrastructure is provided by Microsoft, encompassing Windows Server, Azure, or other Microsoft technologies. Additionally, it utilizes cloud-based applications accessible over the internet. Moreover, the environment employs security measures from various vendors for network security, encompassing firewalls, and antivirus software to safeguard the infrastructure and data.

2. OBJECTIVE

The SADPMR requires a cyber security expert to conduct penetration testing on the network infrastructure, systems, databases, and applications to proactively identify vulnerabilities and weaknesses in the environment that can be exploited remotely and internally.

A well-seasoned Software Quality Assurer is also required to ensure that internal system development processes comply with the required standards.

3. REQUIREMENTS

The SADPMR requires the following services for Networks and Applications:

3.1 Identify Vulnerabilities and Threats: Discover security weaknesses within the network that could be exploited by an attacker, pinpointing potential entry points, and assessing the likelihood and impact of various threats.

3.2 Simulate Cyber Attacks: Mimic real-world attacks to understand how an actual attacker could breach the SADPMR network.

3.3 Expose Human-factor Weaknesses: Highlight security risks associated with human error and the need for improved security training.

3.4 1. Assess Impact of Detected Vulnerabilities: Determine the potential impact of detected vulnerabilities on the organization's operations and reputation.

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3.5 Assess Security Configuration and Management: Evaluate the effectiveness of security configurations and management practices within the network.

3.6 Identify Rogue Devices or Unauthorized Access Points: Detect any unauthorized devices or access points that may compromise network security.

3.7 Gain Insight into Security Posture: Provide a comprehensive view of the network's security readiness and potential areas for improvement.

3.8 Proactive Security Approach: Take preemptive measures to identify and mitigate potential threats before they are exploited.

3.9 Prioritize Risks: Help organizations prioritize security risks based on the severity and likelihood of exploitations.

3.10 User Privilege Auditing: Audit user privileges and access controls to ensure that the principle of least privilege is properly enforced.

3.11 Process Improvement: Implement a continuous improvement cycle (Plan, Do, Check, Act) within the SQA(Software Quality Assurance) processes to enhance software quality over time.

3.12 Comprehensive Testing: Employ a comprehensive testing strategy, including functional, performance, security, and usability testing, to identify and mitigate risk.

3.13 Quality Improvement: Utilize audit findings to systematically improve software quality, addressing identified weaknesses and enhancing product reliability.

3.14 Preparing and implementing quality assurance policies and procedures.

3.15 Documentation and Reporting: Document all findings, methodologies, and recommendations clearly and comprehensively to ensure actionable insights are provided to stakeholders.

3.16 Assess the security of the cloud environment on Microsoft Intra (Azure) and ensure best practices are followed.

3.17 The Software Quality Assurer should possess the following skills:

1. **Test Plan:** A detailed plan outlining scope, objectives, resources, schedule, and test items.

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2. **Test Cases:** Clearly defined scenarios based on system requirements to validate functionality.
3. **Automated Testing Tools:** Tools to automate repetitive and extensive test scenarios.
4. **Performance Testing Setup:** Tools and scripts to evaluate system performance under various conditions.
5. **Security Testing Tools:** Tools to detect vulnerabilities and threats.
6. **Data Integrity Checks:** Ensure data consistency and accuracy during system operations.
7. **Usability Testing Protocols:** Methods to evaluate user experience and interface effectiveness.
8. **Performance Monitoring:** Ongoing assessment of system responsiveness, speed, and capacity.

4. MONITORING AND REPORTING

4.1 The successful bidder will report directly to SADPMR SCM and ICT division.

5. COMPLETION DATE

The expected duration for conducting Network Penetration Testing is three (3) months. The Quality Assurance on Systems Applications for the SADPMR will be six (6) months which will run concurrently.

6. COMPULSORY BRIEFING SESSION

A compulsory information / briefing session will be held virtually via Microsoft teams.
