Execution of a Contract Instruction to Rectify Defects and/or Complete Outstanding Works on an Existing Contract TMT-LDOE-2022/23/LPCL7B at Ladzani Primary School in Vhembe District Municipality

REQUEST FOR QUOTATION

1. Background and Purpose

On behalf of the Limpopo Department Of Education (the "Principal and Project Funder"), The Mvula Trust (the "Employer" and "Implementing Agent"), invites suitably qualified contractors to submit quotations for the execution of a **contract instruction** issued pursuant to **Clause 17.1.8 [making good physical loss and repairing damage to the works]** of the Principal Building Agreement, Edition 4.1 March 2005 ("JBCC") for the completion of outstanding works on an existing contract (**Contract No.TMT-LDOE-2022/23/LPCL7B**) between Employer and the Contractor. The existing contract is for the construction of sanitation facilities and the attendant external works at Ladzani Primary School (the "Site") whose GPS Coordinates are 22°43'3.59" S, 30°33'36.14" E.

2. Scope of Works

The scope of works to be executed entails the completion of outstanding works as measured in the Bill of Quantity below. The works are pursuant to the provisions of Clause 17.4 of the JBCC which gives the Employer the right to procure the services of a third party to cure the Contractor's default in cases where the Contractor does not address a Contract Instruction as contemplated and/or obliged in the contract.

3. Construction Period:

The works must be completed within **4 Weeks** from the date of commencement.

4. Standard Form of Contract

The Principal Building Agreement Edition 4.1 March 2005 ("JBCC").

NB: By virtue of the project been implemented for and on behalf of the Department of Basic Education, the State Provisions [Clause 41.0] of the JBCC will be applicable to this contract.

5. Preconditions

A written quotation will not be considered unless the service provider who submits the quotation provides the following with their quotation.

- Central Supplier Database Registration Report not older than three (3) months.
- Print out of a proof of contractor registration with the CIDB in Grade 2CE/2GB or higher.
- Certificate of Good Standing with Workman Compensation Commissioner. (COIDA)/ Letter to Tender
- Record of Addenda to RFQ Documents.
- Compulsory Questionnaire (must be fully completed).
- Resolution for signatory (must be submitted otherwise the tender will not be considered)
- Certified SPECIFIC GOALS Certificate/Sworn Affidavit.
- Authority of JVs (JV agreement must be attached, If applicable)
- SBD 4 Declaration of Interest.

In terms of the principles governing the ethical conduct of parties in construction procurement (the CIDB Code of Conduct for all parties engaged in construction procurement), in their dealings with each other, the parties should amongst others:

- behave honestly, transparently and equitably,
- satisfy all relevant requirements established in procurement documents,
