I, Ms Tebogo Mashile, Acting Director of the Astronomy Management Authority established by the Minister within the Department of Science, Technology and Innovation, and designated as the management authority for the declared Sutherland Central Astronomy Advantage Areas (SCAAA) in terms of Section 15 of the Astronomy Geographic Advantage Act, 2007 (Act No.21 of 2007), hereby give notice of a public awareness workshop to be held in Sutherland regarding the SCAAA Astronomy Protection Regulations and the Declaration to Prohibit Certain Mining Activities.

The Astronomy Protection Regulations and the Declaration to Prohibit Certain Mining Activities within the SCAAA were published under Notices No. 805 and No. 806 in the Government Gazette No. 42492 on 29 May 2019. The Minister also published the Notice of his intention to amend the Declaration to Prohibit Certain Mining Activities within SCAAA under Notice No. 7008 in Gazette No. 53979 on 21 January 2026.

The purpose of this workshop is to provide communities residing within the SCAAA, as well as interested and affected parties, with a clear understanding of these regulations and prohibitions, their importance for protecting our astronomy geographic advantages and to address any queries that may still exist.
