However, once the adjudication body has approved the process and award of the business to the successful bidder(s), the validity of the successful bidder(s)' bid will be deemed to remain valid until a final contract has been concluded.

**3. DISCLAIMERS**

Please note that **Transnet reserves the right to:**

- a) modify the RFQ's Goods/Services and request Respondents to re-bid on any such changes;
- b) reject any Proposal which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein;
- c) disqualify Proposals submitted after the stated submission deadline [closing date];
- d) award a contract in connection with this Proposal at any time after the RFQ's closing date;




## 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this SOW is for Replacement of tippler bin liners, spill plate and spill plate rollers

## 2. PE MPT BACKGROUND

Port Elizabeth Multi-Purpose Terminal (PEMPT's) core business is to import and export dry bulk cargo manganese ore. This is accomplished with terminal infrastructure such as rail wagon tippler, feeders, conveyor belts, storage facilities, ship-loaders, and a network of mobile equipment such as excavator, sky jacks, cherry pickers and bulldozer.

## 3. OBJECTIVE

The main objective of this SOW for **Replacement/repairs of tippler bin liners, spill plate rollers and tippler curtain structure**

## 4. SCOPE OF WORK:

### 4.1. Replacement of A and B tippler bin liners

- ❖ Clean out the area to inside the bins allow for inspections and to ensure that all defects are identified and attended to.
- ❖ Loosen all identified liners in the bins
- ❖ Remove and send to shop 17 for cutting
- ❖ Have a welder in shop17 to hard face all new liners before they are installed
- ❖ Contractor shall allow to replace at least all damaged liners as identified by TPT rep
- ❖ Were possible contractor shall repair by means of hard facing welding rods as agreed by TPT rep.
- ❖ Contractor to replace the first five rows of lines from the bottom up in all four bins the other rows above can be replaced by exception.

### 4.2. Replacement/welding repairs on A and B spill plate structure

- ❖ Clean out the area under and on top of the spill table to allow for inspections and to ensure that all defects are identified and attended to
- ❖ Position the tippler table such that the spill plate is flat to allow for easy stripping
- ❖ Repair all damaged liners

- ❖ Upon completion of the liner repairs lift up the spill plate
- ❖ Clean out all spill plate rollers
- ❖ Free up all the rollers and make sure all is turning
- ❖ Replace all damaged bearings (Transnet to supply replacement bearings if not supplier will be required to clean the old bearings clean and fit back )
- ❖ Repair the spill plate structure were the rollers are running (possibly replace the channel iron)

#### **4.3. Replacement/welding repairs on A and B spill plate structure**

- ❖ Strip out all curtains (made of conveyor belts conveyor belts )
- ❖ Strip down all existing structure rusted structure
- ❖ Clean out all the ore and sludge and the walkway to ensure that the mounting bases are located to mount new structures.
- ❖ Replace all rusted structure with newly manufactured ones
- ❖ Fit back all curtains (can use new ones or old ones )
- ❖ All structures shall be sand blasted and painted for corrosion protection.
- ❖ Replace all hand rails (Transnet will supply all hand rail material)
- ❖ Mount back and adjust the bin level sensor.
