T1.1 Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

The **CITY OF CAPE TOWN**, Urban Mobility, Roads Infrastructure Management: Infrastructure Systems: Structures Section, invites tenders for Tender No. **47Q/2022/23: THE REPAIR OF THE TOWN CENTRE, MITCHELLS PLAIN PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE.**

Tenderers must be registered on Supplier Databases as described in the tender conditions.

Tenderers who are not registered on these Supplier Databases are not precluded from submitting tenders, but must however be registered upon being requested to do so in writing and within the period contained in such a request.

It is estimated that tenderers must have a CIDB contractor grading designation of **4CE** or higher.

Preferences are offered to tenderers who tender in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017.

Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted.

Tenders may only be submitted on the tender documents that have been issued. Printed Bills of Quantities, in the same format (that is, layout, billed items and quantities) as those issued electronically by the Employer upon request, may be submitted as stated in the Tender Data.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

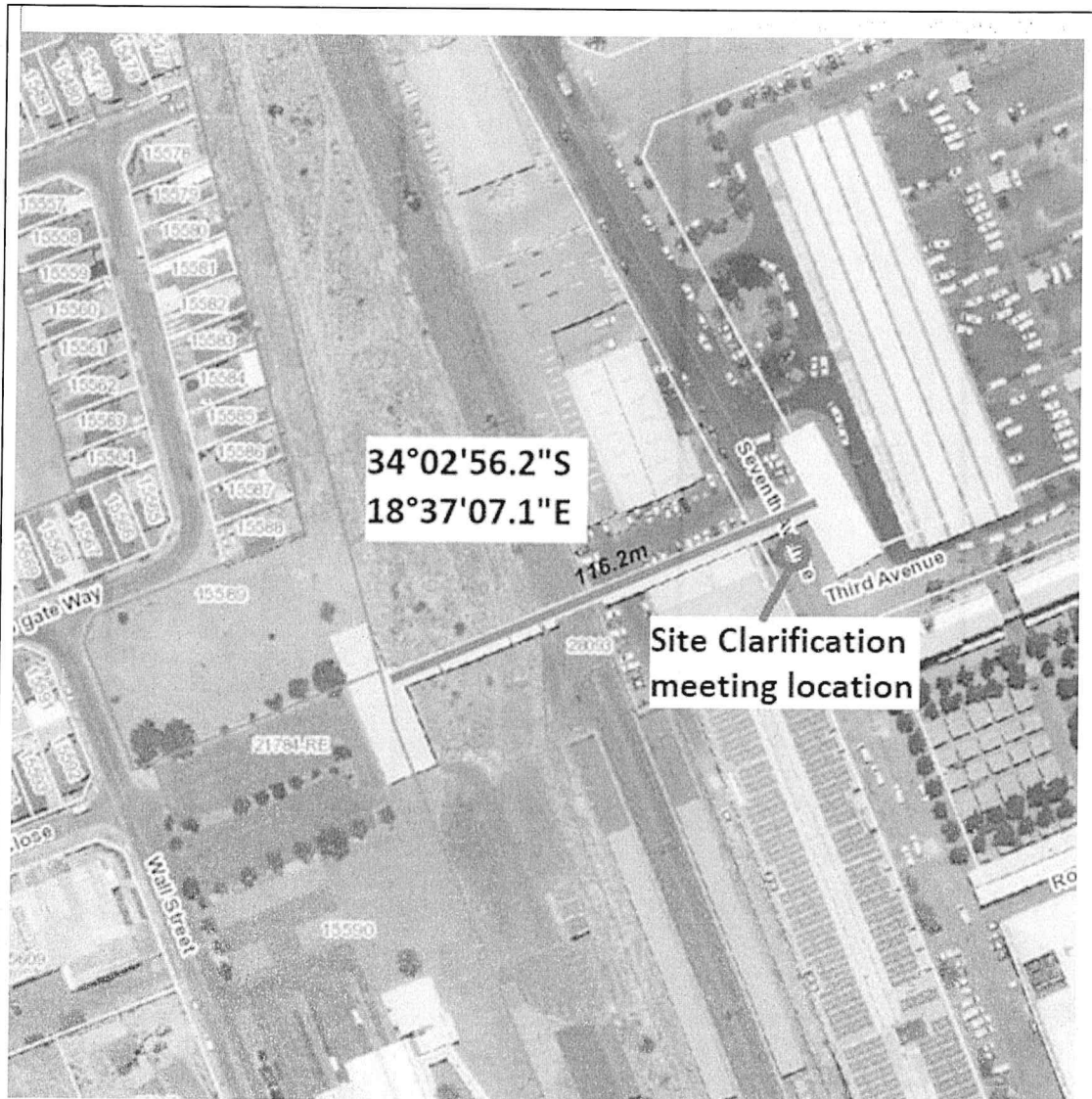

By submitting a tender to the City of Cape Town, (and by concluding any ensuing related agreement with the City of Cape Town, if applicable), the tenderer thereby acknowledges and unconditionally agrees:

- 1.1 that the tenderer has been informed of the purpose of the collections and processing of its personal information as defined in the Protection of Personal Information Act of 2013 ("**POPIA**"), which, for the avoidance of doubt is for, and in relation to, the tender process and the negotiation, conclusion, performance and enforcement of the ensuing agreement, if applicable, as well as for the City of Cape Town's reporting purposes.
- 1.2 To the collection and processing of the tenderer's personal information by the City of Cape Town and agrees to make available to the City of Cape Town, all information reasonably required by the City of Cape Town for the above purposes.
- 1.3 That the personal information the City of Cape Town collects from the tenderer or above the tenderer may be further processed for other activities and/or purposes, which are lawful, reasonable, relevant and not excessive in relation to the purposes set out above, for which it was originally collected.
- 1.4 That, the tenderer indemnifies the City of Cape Town and its officials, employees, and directors and undertakes to keep the City of Cape Town and its official, employees, and directors indemnified in respect of any claim, loss, demands, liability, costs, and expenses of whatsoever nature which may be made against the City of

Cape Town (including the costs incurred in defending or contesting any such claim) in relation to the tenderer or the tenderer's employees', representatives' and/or sub-contractors' non-compliance with POPIA and/or the City of Cape Town failure to obtain the tenderer's consent or to notify the tenderer of the reason for the processing of the tenderer's personal information;

T1.2 Tender Data
