SECTION 3: EVALUATION CRITERIA

3.1 Evaluation Criteria

- 3.1.1 ACSA will use a pre-determined evaluation criteria when considering received bids. 3.5 Functionality

The functionality evaluation will be conducted by the end-user/operations/the Tender Preparation and Evaluation Committee which comprises of various skilled and experienced members from diverse professional disciplines. The evaluation process will be based on functionality criteria. The criteria will be as follows:

3.5.1. Functionality Criteria

The functional evaluation will be based on a threshold, where bidders which fail to achieve a minimum of **70%** on the functional stage will not be considered further in the evaluation. The thresholds on each element of the evaluation are as follows:

Functionality is the terminology used to define the technical ability of the Tenderer, based on experience to deliver the required product in accordance with the specialised quality, reliability and functionality.

Points allocated for Functionality shall be evaluated in accordance with the criteria as listed below. An overall minimum threshold of **70 points out of 100** must be achieved for the tender to be eligible for further evaluation on Price and B-BBEE (80/20 split). Bidders who also fail to achieve the minimum score per criteria will be disqualified and not be eligible for further evaluations.
