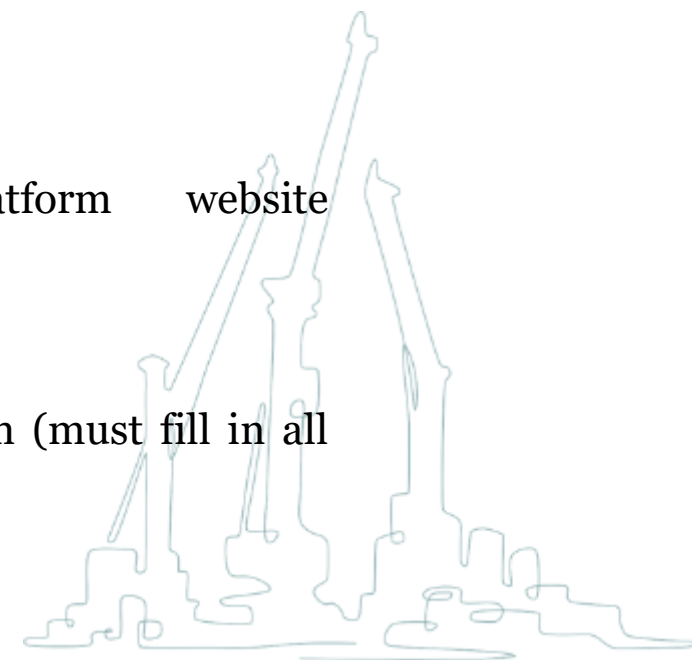
TENDER SUBMISSION

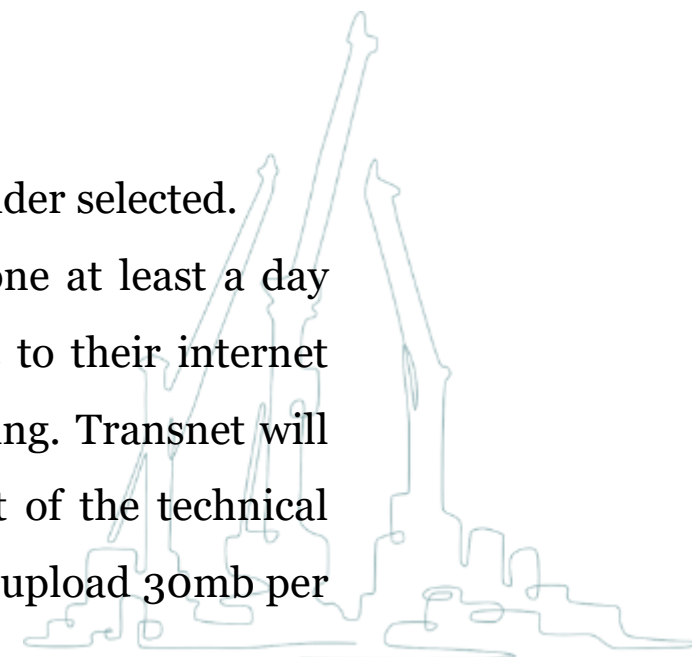

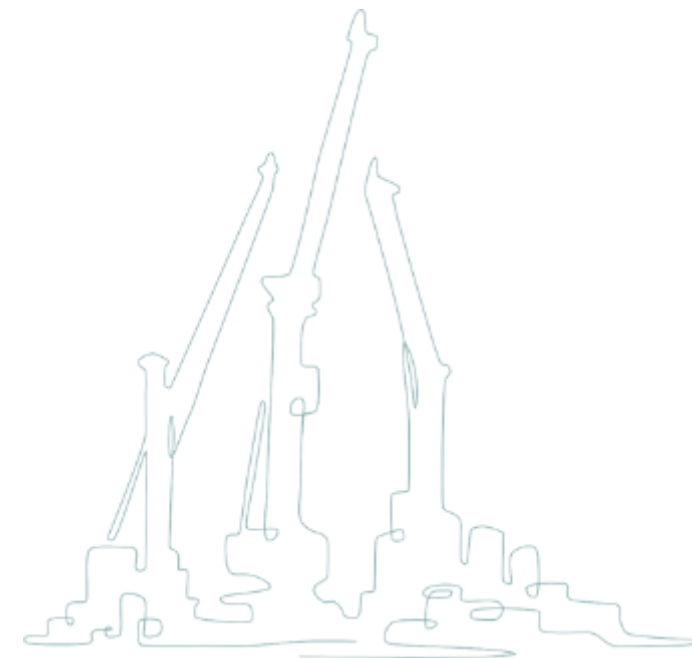

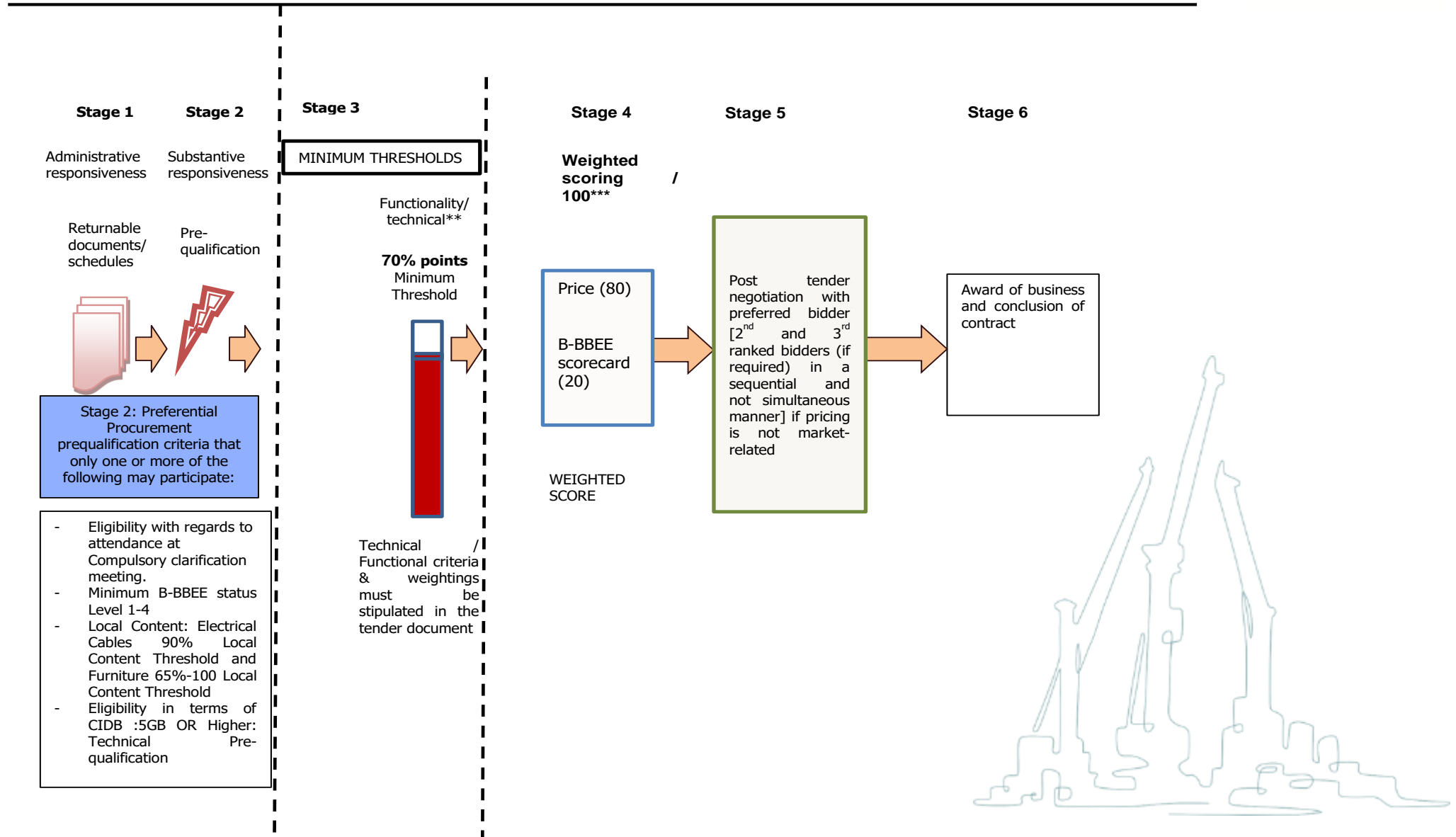

Transnet will utilise the following methodology and criteria in selecting a preferred Service provider, if so required:



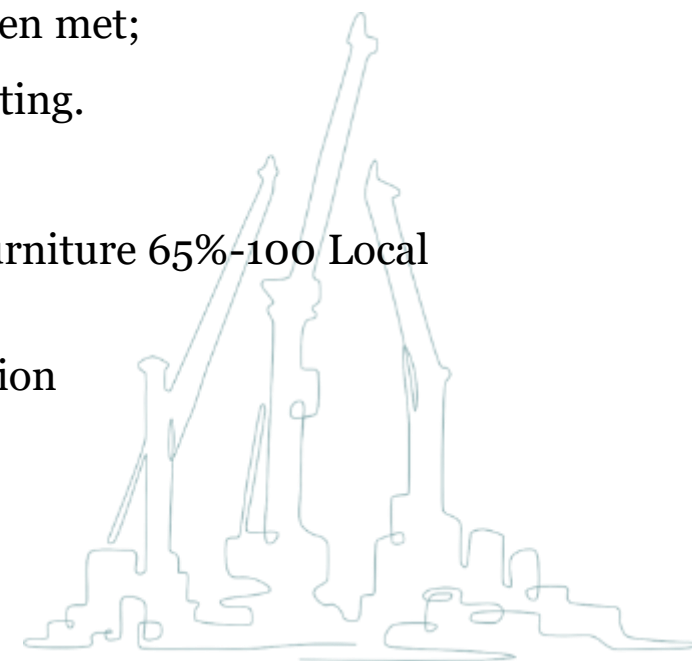
Evaluation Methodology

Stage One: Administrative responsiveness

- Whether the bid has been lodged on time.
- Whether all Returnable Documents and/or schedules were completed and returned by the closing date and time.
- Verify the validity of all Returnable Documents.

Stage Two: Substantive responsiveness

- Whether any general pre-qualification criteria set by Transnet, have been met;
- - Eligibility with regards to attendance at Compulsory clarification meeting.
- - Minimum B-BBEE status Level 1-4
- - Local Content: Electrical Cables 90% Local Content Threshold and Furniture 65%-100 Local Content Threshold
- - Eligibility in terms of CIDB :5GB OR Higher: Technical Pre-qualification
- Whether the Bid contains a Financial offer.



Stage Three - Technical Evaluation

Minimum Threshold of 70% for Technical Criteria and Functional Requirements.

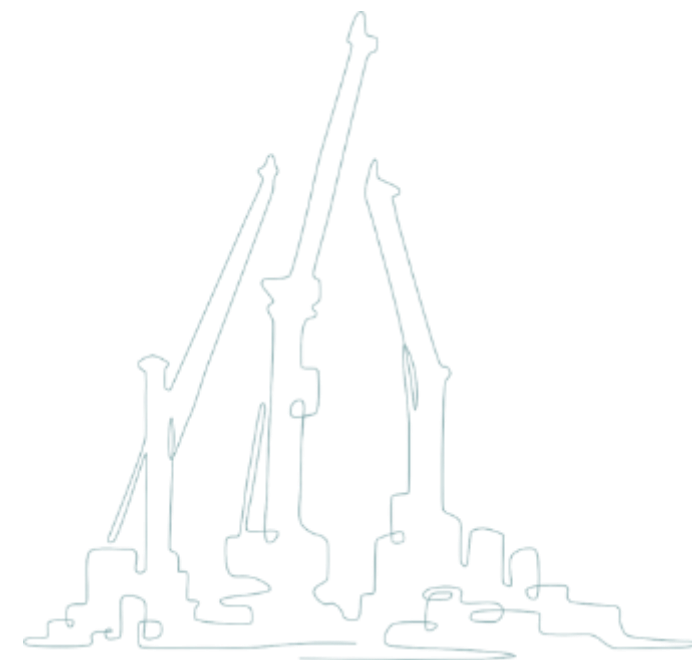
Functionality shall be scored independently by not less than 3 (three) evaluators and averaged in accordance with the following schedules:

- T2.2-04 Eligibility
- T2.2-06 Programme
- T2.2-08 Guarantee and Warranties
- T2.2-07 Previous Experience
- T2.2-05 Quality Assurance Documentation
- T2.2-08A Method Statement

Each evaluation criteria will be assessed in terms of scores of 0, 20, 40, 60, 80 or 100 (linear scale, more suitable for NEC3, ECC (construction related procurement))

The scores of each of the evaluators will be averaged, weighted and then totalled to obtain the final score for functionality, unless scored collectively. (See CIDB Inform Practice Note #9).

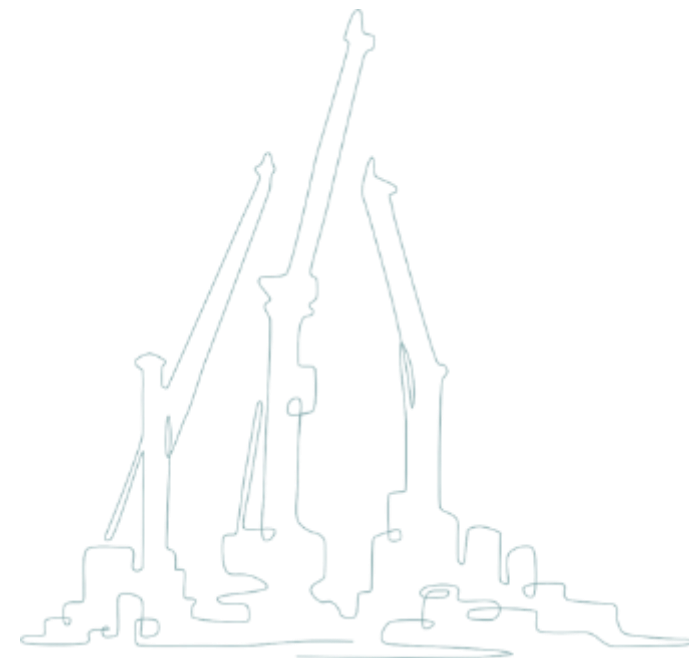

EVALUATION METHODOLOGY

Stage Four: Financial offer and B-BBEE

- Only bidders who have met or exceeded the pre-determined threshold will progress to Stage 4
- Points will be allocated as follows:
 - ✓ Financial Offer (80); and
 - ✓ B-BBEE (20)

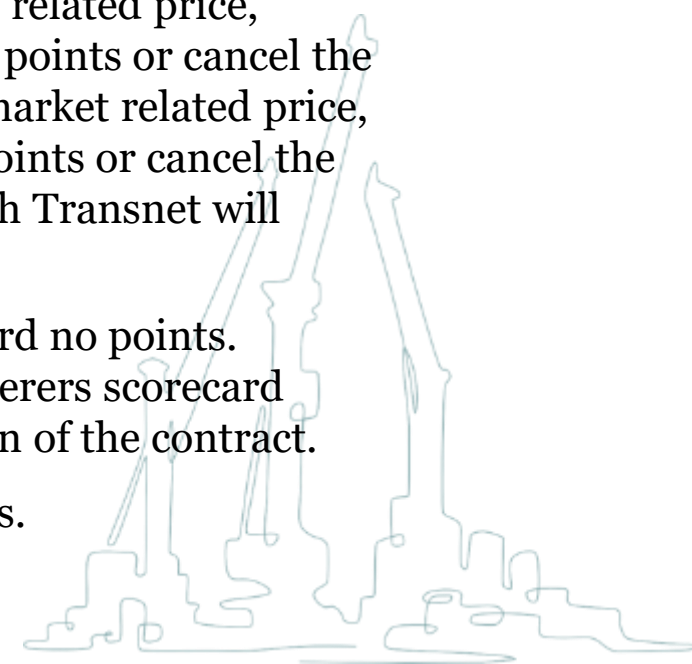


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EVALUATION METHODOLOGY

Stage Five : Tender Negotiations

- Bidders are to note that Transnet may not award a contract if the price offered is not market-related.
- Transnet reserves the right to negotiate market-related price with the tenderer scoring the highest points or cancel the tender; if the tenderer does not agree to a market related price, negotiate a market related price with the tenderer scoring the second highest points or cancel the tender; if the tenderer scoring the second highest points does not agree to a market related price, negotiate a market related price with the tenderer scoring the third highest points or cancel the tender. If the market related price is not agreed as envisaged in this paragraph Transnet will cancel the tender.
- Should the BBBEE rating not be provided, Transnet reserves the right to award no points. Transnet also reserves the right to carry out an independent audit of the tenderers scorecard components at any stage from the date of close of the tenders until completion of the contract.
- Tenderers with no accreditation will score zero points for preference purposes.

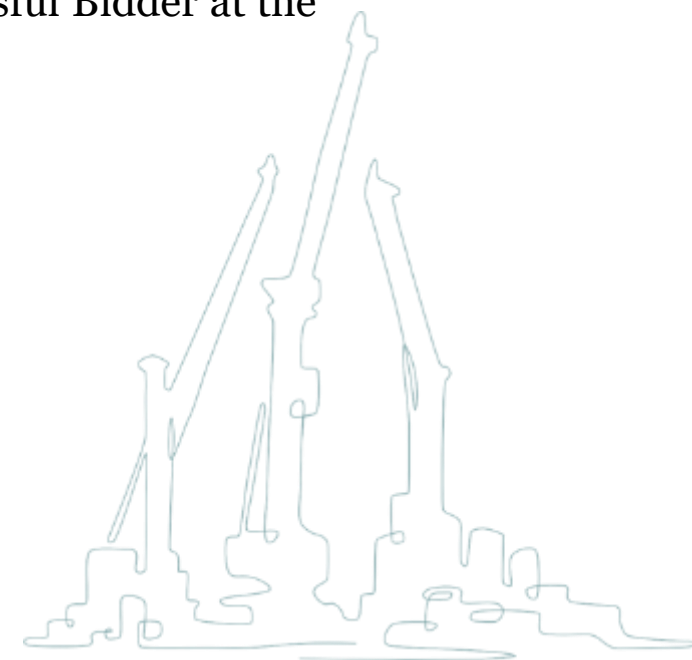

Stage Six: Award of Business and conclusion of contract

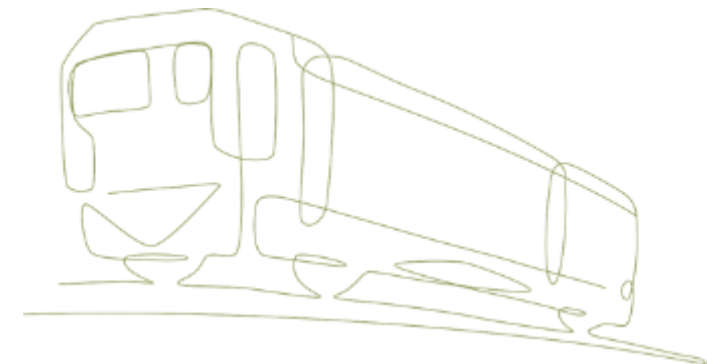
- After approval to award the contract has been received, the successful or preferred bidder(s) will be informed of the acceptance of his/their Quotation by way of a Letter of Award. Thereafter the final contract will be concluded with the successful bidder(s).
- Otherwise, a final contract will be concluded and entered into with the successful Bidder at the acceptance of a letter of award by the bidder.

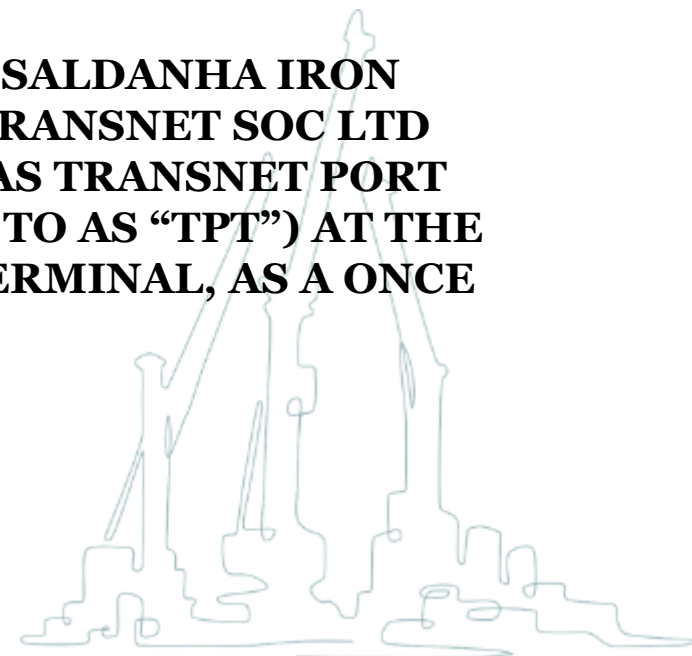
