TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

Knysna Municipality hereby invites tenders for the Upgrading of Rheenendal Bulk Water Supply – Phase 1 in Rheenendal (Ward 5):

- Upgrading of Weir on Homtini river,
- Raw water pumps and sump at Homtini river,
- Refurbishment of existing rising main,
- Raw water storage tank at the Rheenendal WTW,
- Cleaning of raw water balancing dam,
- Drilling and equipping of new boreholes,
- Proposed new pumping main from boreholes,
- Demolishing of old WTW equipment and removal, and
- Bulk meters and zoning

A compulsory clarification meeting will be held on Wednesday 02 April 2025 from 14:00 at the Rheenendal WTW in Rheenendal. Access is via N2 and Rheenendal Road from Knysna. No person/s will be allowed to join the clarification meeting or to submit a bid if such a person/s is more than fifteen (15) minutes late.

The closing time for submission of bids is **12h00 on Tuesday, 15 April 2025**. Bids must be sealed in an envelope clearly marked with the bid number and title given above and placed in the bid box at the **Supply Chain Management Unit, Finance Building, Queen Street, Knysna**, on or before the mentioned time and latest date.

Telephonic, facsimile and late bids will not be accepted. Bids must remain valid for a period of **120** days after the closing date of the bid. Notwithstanding the period of validity of bids as set out in the bid documents, the Municipality reserve the right to request extension of the validity period.

Bids will be opened on the same day at the Supply Chain Management Section at 12h05. Late or unmarked bids will not be considered.

Bidders are required to submit an original of their tender document together with a copy of their tender document and soft copy in a USB. (The original tender document must be clearly marked "Original", and the copy of the tender document must be clearly marked "Copy").

25% of the work to be reserved for local targeted enterprises/EME's (CIDB Grades 1CE to 3CE). Subcontracting will be concluded/finalized after the appointment of the preferred bidder.

The evaluation of this bid will be subjected to functionality scoring. Tenderers must achieve a minimum functionality score of **70 out of 100** points for functionality in order to be evaluated further. The functionality criteria and weighting is set out in the tender document.

Bids may only be submitted on the bid documentation that is issued.

Bids will be evaluated according to the **80/20** preference points system. The bids are subject to the Council Supply Chain Management Policy, Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000, and the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022, as amended.

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to bid and/or re-advertise or to reject any bid or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or to award a contract to the Bidder scoring the highest number of points.

Further requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of bids are stated in the Tender Document.

It is estimated that tenderers must have a CIDB contractor designation of **5 CE** or higher.
