Clarification Nr.1

Question: QCP's are only required for services, this is a supply and delivery tender so how is QCP relevant to this Tender?

Response: Some of the items have clear instruction from the OEM on how they should be handled, therefore a QCP is requires.

Question: E-auction allows suppliers to bid for specific items. How are the suppliers scores on QCP if they want to only bid for specific off-the-shelve items?

Response: Off-the-shelve items also having quality control documents such as **COC, Material certificates, and Material test report** that must form part of their submission for traceability purposes.

Question: The Technical Evaluation Criteria calls for ISO 9001:2015 Certification, as a returnable, will Eskom consider a letter from the accreditor stating that the company is in the process of obtaining one together with a QMS Document as sufficient under the weighing Criteria

Response: The letter from the accredited body will stipulate that the company have applied for QMS equivalent to ISO 9001:2015 Certification which will also have dates for issuing. This will be sufficient evidence for the evaluation.
