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PART 4: SITE INFORMATION

Core clause 11.2(16) states

"Site Information is information which

- describes the Site and its surroundings and
- is in the documents which the Contract Data states it is in."

In Contract Data, reference has been made to this Part 4 of the contract for the location of Site Information.

1. Description of the Site and its surroundings

1.1. General description

The area where the *works* or equipment to be delivered will be within the Port of Richards Bay Boundary. Access to the Port of Richards Bay and the work site(s) or delivery site is Umfolozi building, Machine room workshop area 208 as well as 209 garages, refer to annexure A, B and C. The central point of the site delivery will be Umfolozi building/Fire Station, this is where all the equipment will be checked and accepted by the *Purchaser* and the other equipment that have to be moved to Machine room workshop area 208 as well as 209 garages will then be relocated by the *Supplier*. Access must be subject to the Transnet National Ports Authority security requirements and regulations, which states that "access should be obtain for all the Supplier's personnel at Permit Office located at Sizakala Truck Staging Facility".

There is a permit card access system to enter the Port Area. The Port Staff must arrange the required access permits and issue them to the *Supplier* free of charge. Should any person loose his/her access permit these must be replaced at a cost of R 360-00 per person, cost to be incurred by the *Supplier*. This must also apply if permits are not returned at the end of the project completion.

Normal working hours at the Port of Richards Bay are from 08:00 to 16:30, Monday to Friday, Inclusive. Transnet National Ports Authority has a strict Health and Safety policy in place. No person(s) may enter the site and undertake work on the site until undergoing the mandatory induction. The induction must be arranged by the Port personnel at no cost to the *Supplier*. Prior arrangement must be made with the *Purchaser*.

1.2. Existing buildings, structures, and plant & machinery on the Site

The project scope does not involve construction, but the procurement, delivery and commissioning of the Portable and Emergency Rescue firefighting equipment.

1.3. Subsoil information

1.4. Hidden services

The *Supplier* is to apply care not to damage existing services during delivery and commissioning of equipment. See project specification for further requirements.
