The Denel Overberg Test Range invites quotations from suitably qualifying suppliers for the items below:

A **compulsory** clarification meeting with the representative of the employer shall take place on Tuesday 02 June 2026. Contractors shall assemble at the security main gate at 11:00, at Denel SOC Ltd, trading as DENEL AEROSPACE, located in the Overberg Region of the Western Cape, Waenhuiskrans (Arniston), South Africa. It is +/- 210 kilometers from Cape Town on the R316 road; closing date of RFQ will be 12 June 2026 @11h00

Scope of Work 1

The service provider is required to carry out crash stone cutting and ground levelling using appropriate tools, with the goal of preparing the road surface for the safe transportation of sensitive instrumentation equipment. Excess gravel generated during this process must be redistributed to other designated areas within close proximity.

1. Cut Stones and Level Ground

- Use suitable equipment to cut and crash stones.
- Ensure the road surface is evenly leveled to accommodate the movement of sensitive equipment without risk of damage.
- Minimize uneven surfaces, loose stones, and sharp edges.
- Work must be done carefully to ensure stability and accessibility for transport vehicles.

2. Gravel Redistribution:

- Collect and relocate excess gravel to other specified or nearby operational sites.
- Spread and compact redistributed gravel evenly.

General Requirements:

- Comply with all site safety, environmental, and access regulations.
- Operate machinery with trained personnel only.
- Use dust suppression methods where necessary.
- Clear the site of any debris or leftover material after completion.

Maintain open communication with the site manager for coordination on gravel redistribution locations

Scope of Work 2

The work will involve **removal of existing tar, patching**, and application of **slurry**, including **prime coat and pre-mix**, to restore road surface integrity and functionality.

General Requirements:

- Ensure all leveling and filling work complies with equipment transport safety standards.
- Avoid the creation of loose stone surfaces that could pose a risk to sensitive transport loads.
- Maintain dust control measures throughout the duration of the works.
- Thoroughly clean the site upon completion of all activities.
- The contractor shall guarantee the quality of materials used and warrant workmanship for a minimum period of 12 months, ensuring the road remains in good serviceable condition under normal operational use.

Only those bidders who meet the criteria below, shall be evaluated further on price and preferential points:

- (a) Who are registered with CIDB as 2CE;
- (b) Who have completed at least two “general building” projects of similar nature and extent **(bidders must complete table 1 below);**
- (c) .Who is in good standing with the Building Industry Bargaining Council. **(Bidders must attach a certificate of good standing with the bid, failure to do so will result in disqualification);**
- (d) Who are in good standing with the compensation commissioner **(bidders must attach a copy of the COIDA certificate to this bid)**
