- Municipal account, lease agreement for urban resident for both director and the company not older than 3 months.
- Proof of residence for CLLR from rural residents only for both the director and company not older than 3 months.
- A bidder who is a joint venture has to include MBD 4,8& 9 for each entity in the joint venture/ consortium with his/her bid.
- CK document /proof of company registration not older than 3 months.

- CIDB registration certificate (6CEPE, 6CE or Higher).
- Certified ID copies of members/directors not older than 3 months.
- Original/ certified BBBEE certificate or sworn affidavit.
- Authority of signatory.
- Proof of CSD registration.
- Record of Addenda to tender documents.
- Form of intent to provide performance guarantee.
- Bidders are required to bring their bid documents to the site inspection for signature of the client or consultant representative.
- Company profile.
- In the case of a joint venture/ consortium every member must submit a separate tax clearance certificate/ tax compliance/ pin, other supporting documents and a joint BBBEE certificate or sworn affidavit with the bid documents, failure to submit will disqualify the bid.

- Umvoti Municipality subscribes to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act no.5 of 2000) and therefore gives preference to tenders from emerging contractors or tenders in joint venture with emerging partners.
- Workmen's compensation registration certificate (or proof of payment of contributions in terms of the compensation for occupational injuries and diseases Act No. 130 of 1993).
- The Umvoti Local Municipality subscribes to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000 and Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022. The 80/20 preference points will be applicable, and bids may only be submitted on the bid documentation that is issued.
- Failure to comply with the above will lead to disqualification.
- The municipality reserves the right to conduct background checks on all previous work conducted by bidders.
- **Minimum qualifying score is 70%; bidders that score less than 70 out of 100 points for the functionality criteria will be regarded as submitting a non-responsive bid.**
- The following allocation of points will be used to calculate points for the functionality of bids and bidders should ensure that they submit all stipulated supporting information to be pre-evaluated on the criteria mentioned below:
 - ✓ Experience of the Bidder – 20 Points
 - ✓ Qualification and Experience of the site key personnel's – 20 Points
 - ✓ Plant and equipment – 20 Points
 - ✓ Labour Intensive Design and Methods and SMME Development Construction – 05 Points
 - ✓ Construction Method and Preliminary Programme - 05 Points
 - ✓ Proof of Available Capital – 30 Points
- The below 80/20 preference points will be applicable with specific goals as per Umvoti Municipality Supply Chain Management Policy.
