RFP 1 OF 2025: APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER FOR THE PROVISION OF SUPPORT FOR SAGE 200 AND SAGE 300 FOR A FIXED PERIOD OF 24 MONTHS

1. BACKGROUND

The Nelson Mandela Museum is a not for profit institution established by South Africa's government as an agency of the National Department of Arts and Culture. It was established as part of a portfolio of legacy projects that seek to transform the heritage landscape from the apartheid past. At the same time, it is a resource for promoting economic development through tourism in an impoverished region. The museum primarily houses collections of gifts given by Nelson Mandela to the museum to share his legacy with the nation.

The mandate of the Nelson Mandela Museum (NMM) is to preserve and promote Nelson Mandela's legacy. One of its main strategic goals is to improve the museum's public profile and access. This mandate is executed through the museum's four main facilities, the Qunu Youth and Heritage Centre, Bhunga Building, Ingquza Hill Museum in Flagstaff, and OR Tambo Garden of Remembrance in Bizana (eNkantolo) in Mthatha CBD. The Bhunga Building doubles as the administrative office of the museum.

The Nelson Mandela Museum invites proposals from qualified vendors to provide support and maintenance services for our Sage200 and Sage300 People for a fixed contractual period of 24 months. The SAGE systems stand as a pivotal component within our Finance, Supply Chain, and HR management infrastructure, catering to approximately 60 employees across the Nelson Mandela Museum, encompassing full-time, part-time, casual, contract, and various temporary employees. The required support and maintenance services are aimed at ensuring the seamless operation of the SAGE systems,

promptly addressing any technical issues or inquiries that may arise during the contracted period.

1.1. Security Compliance Mandate

Service providers providing service to the Nelson Mandela Museum are obligated to undergo a security vetting or screening. This measure is essential for safeguarding the integrity and security of the organisation operations, protecting sensitive information, and ensuring compliance with regulatory requirements.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

2.1. Sage 300

The selected vendor will be required for providing support for the SAGE system (Sage300 – HR, Payroll, and ESS), including but not limited to:

- System Maintenance & Support Services for Sage 300 People: HR, Payroll and ESS (which includes customisation development/configuration) for a period of up to 24 months.
- System Upgrades, system failures/interruptions and system enhancements.
- Technical support and issue resolution for system-related queries and incidents.
- Security management, including data protection measures to protect HR data and ensure compliance with relevant regulations
- Maintain up-to-date documentation of system configurations, processes, and procedures, accessible to authorised personnel.
- End-user training and support to facilitate efficient utilisation of the system.
- Sage 300 integration with third party Applications

2.2. Sage 200

The selected vendor will be required for providing support for the SAGE system (Sage200

- Diagnose and solve accounting system technical issues.
- Ensure the Accounting system is fully functional.
- To perform reconciliations, year-end processes, and ensure the system is fully

functional and no technical glitches go unresolved.

- Ensure the NMM team can be supported remotely and onsite whenever required.
- Provide first line, second line, and third-line support to the NMM.
- Be able to provide a seamless call logging process to assist with serviced requests.
- Provide audit reports as and when required.
- Perform application software upgrades as and when these upgrades become available.
- Assist the finance department in developing custom reports.
- Assist with Asset Management module on the system
- Loading yearly budget and locking budget on the system once used up
- Enhance SAGE 200 functionality in accordance with NMM's enhancement requirements
- Ensure the SAGE 200 is backed up as per the NMM backups policy.
- Assist with Cloud migration exercises, and quarterly Disaster Recovery simulation exercises.
- Transfer skills to all the relevant NMM team members

3.2. FORMULAE FOR DISPOSAL OR LEASING OF STATE ASSETS AND INCOME GENERATING PROCUREMENT

3.2.1. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based

- on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
