1. INTRODUCTION

The Petroleum, Oil and Gas Corporation of South Africa (SOC) Ltd (PetroSA) invites tenders for the purchase and removal of surplus drilling, subsea, completion and associated oilfield inventory located at various PetroSA storage facilities in South Africa.

Over time, PetroSA has accumulated a substantial volume of specialised drilling and subsea-related materials as a result of historical offshore exploration and development activities, maintenance campaigns, project cancellations, and changes in operational requirements. A comprehensive internal review and stock assessment has recently been undertaken to identify, categorise, and group these materials for disposal.

The identified materials are now offered for sale by way of a transparent, competitive open-market tender process, structured into defined lots to facilitate efficient bidding, evaluation, and collection.

The inventory offered includes, but is not limited to, subsea and wellhead systems, downhole completion tools and controls, tubulars and threaded connections, casing accessories, cementing tools, workshop spares, rigging and lifting equipment, and restricted perforation-related items. The materials are offered voetstoots, in their current condition, and bidders are encouraged to familiarise themselves with the nature, location, and composition of the items prior to submitting a tender.

All collection and removal activities will be coordinated with PetroSA's Security and Safety Departments to ensure full compliance with company policies and access protocols.

5. TENDER SALE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Tender sale shall be subject to acceptance by the board of PetroSA, the PetroSA Executive Procurement Committee or duly authorised official.
2. Bids shall be valid for a period of 60 days from the closing date. PetroSA reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids in their entirety, or parts thereof, without explanation or liability.
3. Tenderers may submit offers only for the entire lot of scrap material located at the Voorbaai Logistics Base. No subdivision, partial offers, or bids for portions of the lot will be accepted.
4. The successful bidder(s) will be required to lift the stocks within 30 days from the date of letter of acceptance issued by PetroSA.
5. In case the successful bidder(s) fails to lift the stocks within the stipulated period of 30 days, the bidder(s) shall be liable to pay rent and any other costs that might arise as a result of the delay. In addition, successful bidders shall be liable to pay 1% of the total value of the bid, per weekly delay.
6. Tenderers should, prior to the submission of tender, satisfy themselves about the condition, quality, and status of the material which are being offered for sale/ tender on **“as is where is basis”**. PetroSA SOC Limited gives no guarantee or warranty to the workability or condition of the equipment or materials for sale, other than allow each tenderer to familiarise themselves at the site prior to tendering in terms of the Consumer Protection Act. All equipment/material will be sold **“Voetstoots”**. No inquiry in this regard shall be entertained after submission of tender bids.
7. PetroSA reserves all the rights to withdraw item from sale at any time and also reserves all the right to cancel or postpone the tender/sale at any time without assigning any reason.
8. PetroSA reserves all the rights to withdraw any part of the material offered, or reject any price/ tender including the highest tendered amount without assigning any reason. In such an event, the money already paid will be refunded to the intending tenderer without any interest.
9. The purchaser is not entitled to any benefit/ advantage due to any clerical error inadvertent mistake in the terms and conditions or in the description of the property(s).

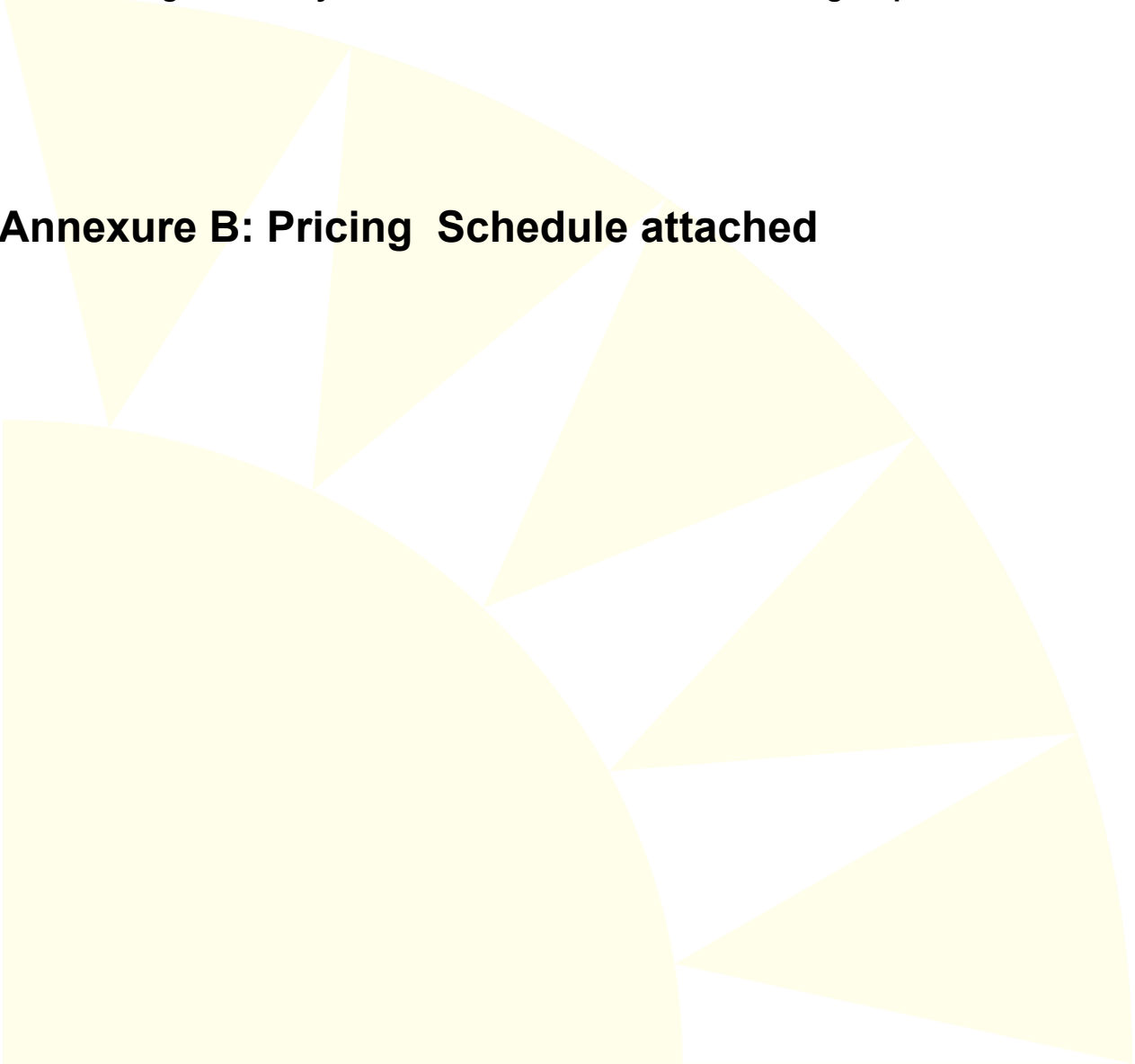

Annexure C: Regulatory Requirements

All bidders participating in this tender process must meet the following minimum regulatory and legal requirements in accordance with South African law/s:

1. **Registration under the Second-Hand Goods Act:**

Where applicable, bidders must be registered under the Second-Hand Goods Act, 2009 (Act 6 of 2009), and must submit a valid SAPS Certificate of Registration relevant to the goods being purchased, including Scrap Metal Dealer/Recycler registration where the goods constitute scrap metal.

2. Failure to submit proof of registration may render the bid non-responsive.

3. **Environmental Compliance:**

All bidders must ensure that their operations, particularly the handling, storage, and transport of scrap metal, comply with:

- The **National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998)**
- The **National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008)**

These Acts govern the protection of the environment, management of waste, and the licensing and control of waste transporters and handlers. Bidders are responsible for ensuring that all necessary authorisations, if applicable, are in place.

4. **Proof of Previous Experience**

PetroSA may consider previous experience in scrap handling or disposal, particularly in industrial or refinery environments.

5. **Health, Safety & Security Compliance:**

Successful bidders will be required to adhere to PetroSA site access protocols, including safety inductions, PPE requirements, and security clearance where applicable.
