TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

Amatola Water Board is a state-owned, South African water utility established in November 1997 and is mandated to render water services to water sector institutions, to local government and other customers in the Eastern Cape.

INVITATION AND SCOPE OF WORK

Suitably experienced and qualified Contractors are invited to respond to this bid invitation for the CONSTRUCTION OF 50 ML/D HIGHBURY WATER TREATMENT WORKS: STAGE 2 CIVILS. The project is located in Mthatha, Eastern Cape.

Only tenderers who are registered with the CIDB (or capable of being so prior to the evaluation of submissions), in a contractor grading designation equal to, or higher, than 8CE and who are also able to satisfy the prequalification criteria stated in the tender data, are eligible to tender.

COMPULSORY BID CLARIFICATION MEETING

A compulsory Bid Clarification Meeting will be held on 14 April 2023. Attendees shall meet at the Thornhill Waterworks, about 150m up the Thornhill Rd from its intersection with the R61 (West) Main Road to Queenstown (at GPS coordinates 31° 34′ 41.84″S 28° 45′ 51.88″E) NO LATER than 11h00 am. Anyone arriving later than the commencement of the meeting (scheduled for 11h00) will not be allowed to enter the gate nor sign the Attendance Register. After the presentation, the Employer's Agent will then lead a convoy from Thornhill Waterworks to the actual Works Site for an appreciation of the Site. It is essential that Bidders refer to the Locality Map of meeting venue on Amatola Water Tender website or in Volume 1 of the tender document. Bidders are to satisfy themselves well beforehand where the Meeting Point is and to seek clarification beforehand if they are not sure of how to get there. Amatola Water will not be held responsible for any Bidder who fails to find the meeting venue before the meeting start time. A rollcall will be made at the end of the clarification meeting. Any bidders listed in the Attendance Register who are found to have left or are missing will be deemed to have not attended the briefing, which is automatic disqualification.

BID CONDITIONS

- The Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 2000 (PPPFA) principles shall apply, whereby submissions will be evaluated accordingly to the provisions of the Act (as amended in November 2022).
- Points for Specific Goals will be scored in accordance with the SBD 6.1 Form. Failure to claim points on SBD 6.1 will lead in non-awarding of points for specific goals.
- Tenders which are late, incomplete, unsigned or submitted electronically will not be accepted.
- All tenders are to remain valid for a period of 12 weeks from the closing date of the submission.
- A Tax Compliance status PIN (an original valid SARS certificate) must be submitted with the tender document in order to be considered.
- Failure to provide all supplementary information specified and completion of the returnable schedules will
 result in the tender being regarded as non-responsive.
- Tender Forms (Form C1.1: Form of Offer and Acceptance) that are incomplete or incorrectly completed will
 result in the disqualification of the tender.
- Only Contractors who meet or exceed ALL the minimum Capability requirements for Tenderer's Expertise
 and Experience and Key Staff qualifications and experience (Contracts Manager, Construction Manager,
 General (Main) Foreman, OH&S Officer) will be considered responsive.
- In addition to fully complying with all the minimum Capability requirements, Bidders are required to confirm that their bid is based on the minimum Participation Goals specified in respect of direct participation of targeted local labour (5% of Contract Value excluding the value of work carried out by any specialist subcontractors for which Prime Cost items are provided in the BoQ) and targeted local enterprises (25% of Contract Value excluding the value of work carried out by any specialist subcontractors for which Prime Cost items are provided in the BoQ).
- Amatola Water does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right to accept any tender or portion of tender.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The 90/10 preference points system as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Regulations, November 2022 pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, (ACT No 5 of 2000) (PPPFA) will be applied to evaluate all bids. The lowest acceptable bid will score 90 points for price and a maximum of 10 points will be awarded according to the Specific Goal points claimable in respect of Preferential Status.

Bids received will be evaluated in three (3) stages; namely Determine the Completeness of Tender Offer, compliance with minimum Capability Requirements and Price and Specific goals.

BID PUBLICATION

Bid documents will be available from 09:00 am on 06 April 2023 at Reception at Amatola House, 6 Lancaster Road, Vincent, East London and then during working hours between 08:00 – 16:00. A non-refundable fee of R750.00 is payable for each set of bid documents. Payment is to be made by either bank deposit or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) only (no cash or cheque payments will be accepted) and is to be made payable to Amatola Water, Nedbank, Account No. 1210394685, Branch Code, 198765. The proof of deposit is required to collect tender documents. No tender documents will be sold at the briefing meeting.

BID SUBMISSION

The original completed bid documents must be submitted in a sealed envelope or parcel endorsed with the Bid Number and Bid Description as detailed in the Tender Data. The sealed envelope must be deposited in the Bid/Tender Box located in the reception area of Amatola House, 6 Lancaster Rd, Vincent, East London, prior to the time and date indicated in the bid notice and the Tender Data. The bid submissions will be opened in public shortly the closing time.
