 - iii) In the event of a contract being awarded as a result of points claimed as shown in paragraphs 1 4 and 6 1, the contractor may be required to furnish documentary proof to the satisfaction of the purchaser that the claims are correct,
 - iv) If the B-BBEE status level of contributor has been claimed or obtained on a fraudulent basis or any of the conditions of contract have not been fulfilled, the purchaser may, in addition to any other remedy it may have —
 - (a) disqualify the person from the bidding process,
 - recover costs, losses or damages it has incurred or suffered as a result of that person's conduct;
 - (c) cancel the contract and claim any damages which it has suffered as a result of having to make less favourable arrangements due to such cancellation.
 - (d) recommend that the bidder or contractor, its shareholders and directors, or only the shareholders and directors who acted on a fraudulent basis, be restricted by the National Treasury from obtaining business from any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years, after the audi alteram partem (hear the other side) rule has been applied, and
 - (e) forward the matter for criminal prosecution.
