1.1 Collection of RFQ documents

1.2 Submission of response

The bids must have, the bidder's return address, the full description of the RFQ, RFQ number and the details of the SCM official where the bid will close. The bids must be signed and completed by a person who has been given authority to act on behalf of the bidding entity. The bottom of each page of the bid documents must be signed or stamped with the bidder's stamp as proof that the bidder has read the RFQ documents.

Emailed and Faxed bids WILL NOT be accepted. Bids must only be submitted on the original documentation. ACSA will not be liable for any costs incurred in the preparation of the tender nor shall ACSA be held liable for any bid documents submitted via courier after the closing date and time.

RFQ must be submitted on or before **11H00 Monday 23 May 2022**. No late submissions will be accepted

Bidders may not contact any ACSA employee on this RFQ other than those listed above. Contact will only be allowed between the successful bidder and ACSA Business Unit representatives after the approval of a recommendation to award this RFQ. Contact will also only be permissible in the case of pre-existing commercial relations which do not pertain to the subject of this RFQ.

1.6 Bid responses

Quotations must be strictly prepared and returned in accordance with this RFQ document. Bidders may be disqualified where they have not materially complied with any of ACSA's requirements in terms of this RFQ document. Changes to the bidder's submission will not be allowed after the closing date of the RFQ. All bid responses will be regarded as offers unless the bidder indicates otherwise.

No bidder or any of its consortium/joint venture members may have an interest in any of the other bidder/joint venture/consortium participating in this bid.

1.7 Disclaimers

It must be noted that ACSA may:

- a) Award the whole or a part of this RFQ;
- b) Split the award of this RFQ;
- c) Negotiate with all or some of the shortlisted bidders;
- d) Award the RFQ to a bidder other than the highest scoring bidder where objective criteria allow; and/or
- e) Cancel this RFQ.

1.8 No Contact Policy

Neither Bidders, nor their members (if consortia), nor their respective advisers, may contact officers, employees or advisers of ACSA, save as provided for in point 1.6 above, in connection with the RFQ or the submission of bids at any time after the Clarification and Communication closing date. Contact will however be permissible only in the case of pre-existing commercial relations, in which case contact may be maintained only in terms thereof. In making such allowed contact, neither Bidders nor their members, nor anyone acting on behalf of any Bidder or member, may make reference to this RFQ or bid in response thereto. The “no contact policy” will not apply in relation to any information deemed to be in the public domain, or which is readily available from organs of state.

1.9 Conflict of Interest

Bidders are required to identify and to disclose as soon as possible any conflict of interest or potential conflict of interest to ACSA. Bidders should contact ACSA for clarity on whether a conflict of interest actually exists or not. The existence of a conflict of interest or a failure by a bidder to timeously disclose any such conflict or part conflict, may result in the bidder's bid being disqualified.

1.10 Validity Period

In order for ACSA to thoroughly evaluate responses, it requires a validity period of Eighty-four (84) business/working days, therefore the prices which have been quoted by the bidder must remain firm and valid for such period. It is only in exceptional circumstances where ACSA would accommodate a proposal to change the prices submitted.

1.11 Confidentiality of Information

ACSA will not disclose any information furnished to ACSA through this tender process to a third party or any other bidder without the prior written approval of the bidder whose information is sought.

Furthermore, ACSA will not disclose the names of the bidders until the tender process has been finalised.

Bidders may not disclose any information provided to them as part of this process to any third party without the prior written approval of ACSA. In the event that the bidder requires to consult with third parties on the contents of this RFQ document, such third parties must complete and sign confidentiality agreements, which should be returned to ACSA as part of response submission to this tender process.

3.2 Evaluation Criteria

a) Pre – qualification

To advance certain designated groups in line with Regulation 4 of the 2017 PPPFA Regulations, only the following bidders will be considered for the tender:

- Tenderer having a B-BBEE status level of contributor 1 or 2;

N.B: Valid SANAS accredited BBBEE certificate or sworn affidavit must be submitted. Bidder who fail to comply with the above requirement will be disqualified at this stage.

b) Mandatory requirements

Bids that do not meet all of the following criteria (valid proof/certification must be provided if required) will be disqualified and will not be evaluated further:

- Bidders must complete in full and sign ACSA Terms and Conditions – Appendix C
- Completed in full and signed Form of offer C1.1. (Found in the NEC 3 Term service Contract)
- Only bidders who have a valid CIDB contractor grading of **4SO or 4GB** or higher

Please note that CIDB grading 3SO PE or 3GB PE will not be accepted

c) Functionality-Evaluation

The functionality/technical evaluation will be conducted by the Bid Evaluation Committee which comprises of various skilled and experienced members from the organization. The evaluation process will be based on threshold criteria. Points allocated for Functionality shall be evaluated in accordance with the criteria as listed below. An overall minimum threshold of **50 points out of 100** must be achieved for the tender to be eligible for further evaluation on Price and B-BBEE (80/20 split). Bidders who also fail to achieve the minimum score per criteria will be disqualified and not be eligible for further evaluations.

- The Employer will award the Contract to a Tenderer who is qualified to undertake the Works and whose Tender technically and contractually complies with the specification.
