The following mandatory documents must be submitted with the completed bid document/tender document and failure to submit will lead to the bids being declared non-responsive:

- Price(s) quoted must be valid for at least ninety (90) days from the date of your offer.
- Price(s) quoted must be firm and must be inclusive of VAT.
- A valid SARS TAX Compliance status with PIN.
- Company municipal Statement of account not later than three (3) months or company lease agreement if renting premises or affidavit from SAPS stating that the company is not obliged to pay municipal rates or company ward council letter for non-rate paying areas and rural areas.
- Updated Central Supplier Database (CSD) report.
- Company registration documents.
- Bank rating.
- Bank statements not older than 3 months.
- Two years signed off financial statements.

- Joint Ventures to attach: JV Agreement and letter of Signatory.
 - Proof of valid COIDA company registration certificate.
 - CIDB requirement: valid 4GB/ higher.
 - Asbestos Certificate (Removal & Handling) from Department of Labour/ bidder must submit either: a valid registration certificate for asbestos removal; or a signed agreement with a company that holds a valid registration certificate for asbestos removal; the signed agreement must be supported by a valid proof of registration as an asbestos removal contractor (valid Asbestos removal certificate).
- A valid proof of public liability insurance/Letter of intent for liability Insurance of R 3 000 000.00

Bidders should take note of the following bid conditions:

- Ingwe does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or any other bid and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of the bid.
