PetroSA requires the services of an AIA qualified service provider to review and update the existing Major Hazard Installation (MHI) Risk Assessment, executed in 2016/2017, on PetroSA sites to ensure risks to employees and public identified, assessed, minimised and controlled as per Quantified Major Hazard Installation (MHI)
