1.1 DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE: SUPPLY, DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION OF A 3.4KVA UPS

BACKGROUND:

The ARC Infruitec-Nietvoorbij has established the AGRI-Food Analytics with a mandate to provide analytical services to Researchers, Technicians and Students within the Institute as well as to external Industry clients. The establishment of the laboratory falls within the Institute's broader plan to strengthen Analytical, Diagnostic and Consultation Services. The aims of which are to: i) minimize expenses (via outflow of funds) with regard to outsourcing of analyses by Researchers; ii) intensively generate additional income stream for the ARC; and, iii) develop human capacity for the ARC and the Industry.

PURPOSE:

To procure a 3.4kVA UPS for the Alpha Wine Analyzer to ensure uninterrupted power supply.

SCOPE OF WORK

The Alpha Wine analyser is one of the major pieces of equipment used by the AGRI-Food Analytics laboratory to offer routine services and is a very sensitive piece of equipment. ARC Researchers and technicians submit grape must samples for analysis during the harvest period. These samples must be analysed on the day that they are harvested and processed to prevent any biochemical changes from occurring. Many projects rely on this analysis to establish optimum harvesting parameters. External clients rely on the accuracy of the results for their research and publications. Due to the volume of samples, the autosampler must be run overnight to accommodate the workload. With the current electricity crisis that SA is faced with these interruptions will negatively affect the performance of the laboratory as well as income generation for the ARC.
