Tender document must be deposited into the Tender Box situated at the reception of uMshwathi Local Municipality's main offices (Main Road/ R33 Road; Opposite Police Station; New Hanover; 3230) on or before 12h00 PM, 16 February 2023, Thursday. No late or faxed or emailed tenders will be considered.

Tenders will be evaluated using Administrative Compliant, Functionality and the 80/20 principles of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, No. 5, 2000 with its 2017 Regulations. Only tenderers meet minimum qualifying score of **(60%)** on functionality as detailed in the tender document shall qualify for further evaluation.

Tenders shall be valid for a period of 90 days. The uMshwathi Local Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender.
