Tenderers must be registered on Supplier Databases as described in the tender conditions.

Tenderers who are not registered on these Supplier Databases are not precluded from submitting tenders, but must however be registered upon being requested to do so in writing and within the period contained in such a request.

It is estimated that tenderers must have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 9CE.

Preferences are offered to tenderers who tender in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017. In terms of these Regulations, a preference point system of 90/10 will be applicable.

Furthermore, only those tenderers who meet the following pre-qualification criteria will be declared responsive:

- a) a tenderer subcontracting a minimum of 30% to:
  - i. an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people;
  - ii. an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are youth;
  - iii. an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are women;
  - iv. an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people with disabilities;
  - v. an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people living in rural or undeveloped areas or townships;
  - vi. a co-operative which is at least 51% owned by black people;
  - vii. an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are military veterans;
  - viii. an EME or QSE.

This tender is subject to Regulation 8 "Local Production and Content" of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000: Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017. Failure to meet the minimum stipulated threshold for local production and content will result in a bid being declared non-responsive.
