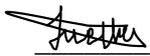

Crushed stone shall be clean, hard, durable and sound crushed (granite) stone of aggregate size between 26,5mm and 37,5mm nominal size as stipulated in [2] and should have a wet resistivity value of at least 3000Ωm. Prior to acceptance of any crushed stone the aggregate report shall be submitted to the Substation Design Engineer for approval. The aggregate report shall include the grading result from the sieve analysis, wet resistivity values (refer to [4]) and an XRD analysis of the stone.  No crusher-run (road construction material or stone from mining activities (contaminated with chemicals)) will be accepted as yard stone.
