Tenderers must not in any way contact any Eskom employee who is involved in the tender during the tender process, either telephonically, by email or through private appointments before and after submitting tenders. Eskom employees not involved in this tender are not allowed to contact employees involved in this tender or provide information about the tender to potential tenderers.

#### 1. APPLICATION OF CPA

Eskom will afford Tenderers an opportunity to propose additional/alternate offers to the abovementioned. Additional Offers, which are optional, will only be considered if a fully compliant Main Offer is submitted and acceptable

CPA conditions may apply if the contractual duration is to be longer than 12 months. If the contractual duration will be less than or equal to 12 months, a fixed priced offer must be submitted.

#### 2. TENDER SUBMISSIONS

Tenderers shall comply with the following requirements:
