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1. Background

Vaal Central Water Board derives its primary mandate from the Water Services Act, Act 108 of 1997 and is, in terms of the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA), Act 1 of 1999, Schedule 3B, a National Government business entity, which reports to the Executive Authority, represented by the Minister of Water and Sanitation through the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS).

Vaal Central is a Water Board with the mandate to provide water services to the Southern and Central areas of the Free State Province and the Northern Cape respectively.

2. Objectives of the Short-Term Insurance Function

Providing short-term insurance is crucial for Vaal Central Water as it provides financial protection against unforeseen events and damage. This ensures that the entity can quickly recover and continue its operations without significant financial strain. Additionally, it helps in maintaining the trust and reliability of their services among stakeholders and customers.

The short-term insurance covers a range of risks including property damage, equipment, and liability claims. It also includes coverage for natural disasters such as floods and fires, which are particularly important given the entity's reliance on water resources. Furthermore, it protects against potential business interruptions, ensuring that Vaal Central Water can maintain its operations and service delivery even in the face of unexpected challenges.

The document aims to secure comprehensive coverage to mitigate risks associated with the organization's movable and immovable assets.

3. Vaal Central Water specific goals

In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. Required Competencies

1. The successful bidder must be fully competent to adequately provide comprehensive short-term insurance cover to meet all the needs of Vaal Central Water which will inform the contractual basis between the parties.
2. The successful bidder must comply with all legislative and relevant regulatory requirements, by the Financial Sector Conduct Authority (FSCA) / Financial Advisory and Intermediary Services (FAIS).
3. The bidder must have minimum public liability insurance of R10 000 000.
4. The bidder must have minimum professional indemnity of R5 000 000.
5. The bidder is required to submit valid proof of registration with FSCA.
6. The successful bidder will be required to submitted proof of registration annually during the duration of the contract.
7. No legal or other obligation shall arise between the service provider and Vaal Central Water unless/until both parties have signed a formal contract, or a Service Level Agreement is in place
8. Compile the Claims Procedure Manual and share with the entity for endorsement.
9. Review cover, limits and sum insured annually or ad hoc.
10. Review uninsured risk exposure and advise on additional insurance requirements.
11. Compilation of detailed insurance manual as well as full summary on cover, limits, conditions, and exclusions.
12. Provide ad hoc training where required in terms of policy and procedure manual.
13. Provide quarterly reports on claims (claims processed and paid out/finalised/closed/rejected, claims in progress)

The Bidder must comply with the minimum requirements in accordance with the functionality criteria listed above and must score at least 70 points for Functionality. Bids that fall below the minimum threshold of 70 points will be regarded technically unacceptable and will not be considered.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. Definitions

Unless otherwise indicated the following words shall bear the following meanings:

- 1.1 The "Company" shall mean Vaal Central Water except where it is clear that it refers to the entity offering Short-Term Insurance brokering services, the "tender or bid" shall mean a tender or bid for the provision of Short-Term Insurance broker services for Vaal Central Water at agreed fees, terms and conditions.
- 1.2 The "tenderer or bidder" shall mean any duly accredited person or persons or anybody, incorporated or otherwise, entity submitting a tender to arrange Short-Term Insurance broker services to Vaal Central Water.
- 1.3 The "contract period" shall commence on 01 July 2026 to 30 June 2031 on the condition that Vaal Central Water would have the option to require a re-assessment of Short-Term Insurance broker services requirements on a year-to-year basis i.e. for periods ending June 2032 and June 2033. It however remains the responsibility of the appointed Short-Term Insurance broker services to optimally perform to the benefit of the Vaal Central Water at all times.

2. Failure to perform

2.1 If -

- (a) Vaal Central Water should suffer any damage as a result of the tenderer's failure to perform as instructed or required and expected, it is agreed that the tenderer will pay to Vaal Central Water the following amounts, in each case to be determined by the Chief Executive of Vaal Central Water, as liquidated damages and not as a penalty;
 - i) in the event of (a) an amount equal to any additional costs over and above the tender price incurred by Vaal Central Water together with all related costs and expenses involved;
 - or
 - ii) in the event of (b), an amount not exceeding the actual damage and costs sustained or incurred by Vaal Central Water; or

- iii) including any possible claim instituted against the tender professional indemnity insurance.

2.2 The Chief Executive of Vaal Central Water will also determine the manner in which and the time when such payment of additional costs and or damages are to be paid to Vaal Central Water, and the decision of the Chief Executive Officer of Vaal Central Water will be final and binding in each case and on all parties.

3. Alternatives

The tenderer may submit an alternative proposal, which, in his opinion, are to Vaal Central Water's advantage economically and technically but it should be clearly indicated as such.

4. Variation

In the event that tenderers are offering any services and or products differing or varying from the requirements of this specification, all such variations shall be clearly indicated and described in the tender response.

5. Tender offer validity

VCW requires a validity period of (**120 Business days**) from closing date against this RFP, excluding the first day and including the last day. VCW may at any time prior to the expiry of the bid validity period, extend the above validity period by 60 days written notice in the VCW website and E-tender website, on the same terms and conditions. In that event, VCW will not require consent from the bidders, and bidders will not be required or permitted to amend any of their proposals. However, bidders are not obliged to extend the validity period. In the case where bidders are not in agreement with the validity extension, they must inform VCW in writing and their proposals will be considered non-responsive.

Once the adjudication body has approved the process and award of the business to the successful bidder(s), the validity of the successful bidder(s)' bid will be deemed to remain valid until a final contract.

6. Fees

- 6.1. Any fees by any name or intention, stated will be inclusive of VAT.
- 6.2. Fees quoted shall be in respect of twelve (12) months period as from 01 July 2026 to 30 June 2027. Fees for the 1st year of insurance must be fixed and must be commissioned based on Year 2.
- 6.3. Any proposed increases of fees for the period following 01 July 2027 should be clearly indicated as a percentage (%).

7. **Payment of premiums**

The premium payment for the period from 01 July 2026 will be made in terms of the Short-term Insurance Act and on receipt of all draft or original policy documents or proof of placement of cover and tax invoices as well as an Executive Summary of the cover stating e.g., type of cover, amount of cover, material exclusions and conditions.

In the event of an increase or decrease in assets and insurable interests, to be made through declarations, the premium will be adjusted or refunded accordingly.

Vaal Central Water may deduct any amount owing to Bloem Water by the short-term insurance broker under any of the provisions of this contract from any amount owing in respect of this insurance and/or risk financing portfolio. Cover must remain in full force and effect during the period that this requirement applies.

8. **Information to be provided by tenderer.**

No tender will be considered, unless accompanied by sufficient information so as to indicate that the fee proposed will include the total cost of arranging and management of the insurance and risk financing portfolios including the claims management for the period 01 July 2026 to 30 June 2031.

9. **Alternatives**

The tenderer may submit an alternative proposal, which, in his opinion, is in Bloem Water's advantage economically and technically.

STANDARD CONDITIONS OF TENDER

1. GENERAL

1.1 Actions

The employer and each tenderer submitting a tender offer shall comply with the conditions of tender. In their dealings with each other, they shall discharge their duties and obligations, as set out in sections 2 and 3, timeously and with integrity, and behave equitably, honestly and transparently.

1.2 Tender documents

The documents issued by the employer for the purpose of a tender offer are listed in the tender data.

1.3 Interpretation

1.3.1 The tender data and additional requirements contained in the tender schedules that are included in the returnable documents are deemed to be part of the conditions of tender.

1.3.2 The conditions of tender, the tender data and tender schedules which are only required for tender evaluation purposes, shall not form part of any contract arising from the invitation to tender.

1.4 Communication and employer's agent

Each communication between the employer and a tenderer shall be to or from the employer's agent only, and in a form that can be read, copied and recorded. Writing shall be in the English language.

The employer shall not take any responsibility for non-receipt of communications from or by a tenderer. The name and contact details of the employer's agent are stated in the tender data.

1.5 The Employer's right to accept or reject any tender offer

1.5.1 The employer may accept or reject any variation, deviation, tender offer, or alternative tender offer, and may cancel the tender process and reject all tender offers at any time before the formation of a contract. The employer shall not accept or incur any liability to a tenderer for such cancellation and rejection, but shall give reasons for such action.

1.5.2 After the cancellation of a tender process or the rejection of all tender offers the employer may abandon the proposed procurement and re-issue a similar tender notice and invitation to tender not less than six months after the closing date for tender offers or have it performed in another manner at any time.

2. TENDERER'S OBLIGATIONS

2.1 Eligibility

Submit a tender offer only if the tenderer satisfies the criteria stated in the tender data and if the tenderer, or any of his principles, is not under any restriction to do business with the employer.

2.2 Cost of tendering

Accept that the employer will not compensate the tenderer for any costs incurred in the preparation and submission of a tender offer, including the costs of any testing necessary to demonstrate that aspects of the offer comply with requirements.

2.3 Check documents

Check the tender documents on receipt for completeness and notify the employer of any discrepancy or omission.

2.4 Confidentiality and copyright of documents

Treat as confidential all matters arising in connection with the tender. Use and copy the documents issued by the employer only for the purpose of preparing and submitting a tender offer in response to the invitation.

2.5 Reference documents

Obtain, as necessary for submitting a tender offer, copies of the latest version of standards, specifications, conditions of contract and other publications, which are not attached but which are incorporated into the tender documents by reference.

2.6 Acknowledge addenda

Acknowledge receipt of addenda to the tender documents, which the employer may issue, and if necessary apply for an extension to the closing time stated in the tender data, in order to take the addenda into account.

2.7 Site visit and clarification meeting

Attend, where required, a site visit and clarification meeting at which tenderers may familiarize themselves with aspects of the proposed work, services or supply, and raise questions. Details of the meeting(s) are stated in the tender data.

2.8 Seek clarification

Request clarification of the tender documents, if necessary, by notifying the employer at least five working days before the closing time stated in the tender data.

2.9 Insurance

Be aware that the extent of insurance to be provided by the employer (if any) might not be for the full cover required in terms of the conditions of contract identified in the contract data. The tenderer is advised to seek qualified advice regarding insurance.

2.10 Pricing the tender offer

2.10.1 Include in the rates, prices and the tendered total of the prices (if any) all duties, taxes (except value-added tax (VAT)), and other levies payable by the successful tenderer, such duties, taxes and levies being those applicable 14 days before the closing time stated in the tender data.

2.10.2 Show VAT payable by the employer separately as an addition to the tendered total of the prices.

2.10.3 Provide rates and prices that are fixed for the duration of the contract and not subject to adjustment except as provided for in the conditions of contract identified in the contract data.

2.10.4 State the rates and prices in Rand unless instructed otherwise in the tender data. The conditions of contract identified in the contract data may provide for part payment in other currencies.

- 2.13.3 Submit the parts of the tender offer communicated on paper as an original plus the number of copies stated in the tender data, with an English translation of any documentation in a language other than English, and the parts communicated electronically in the same format as they were issued by the employer.
- 2.13.4 Sign the original and all copies of the tender offer where required in terms of the tender data. The employer will hold all authorized signatories liable on behalf of the tenderer. Signatories for tenderers proposing to contract as joint ventures shall state which of the signatories is the lead partner whom the employer shall hold liable for the purpose of the tender offer.
- 2.13.5 Seal the original and each copy of the tender offer as separate packages marking the packages as "ORIGINAL" and "COPY". Each package shall state on the outside the employer's address and identification details stated in the tender data, as well as the tenderer's name and contact address.
- 2.13.6 Where a two-envelope system is required in terms of the tender data, place and seal the returnable documents listed in the tender data in an envelope marked "financial proposal" and place the remaining returnable documents in an envelope marked "technical proposal". Each envelope shall state on the outside the employer's address and identification details stated in the tender data, as well as the tenderer's name and contact address.
- 2.13.7 Seal the original tender offer and copy packages together in an outer package that states on the outside only the employer's address and identification details as stated in the tender data.
- 2.13.8 Accept that the employer will not assume any responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the tender offer if the outer package is not sealed and marked as stated.

2.14 Information and data to be completed in all respects

2.15 Closing time
