

HEALTH AND SAFETY


The South African Radio Astronomy Observatory (SARAO) provides scientific radio astronomy, engineering, design and development, construction, operation and maintenance services for radio telescope projects and sites in South Africa and on the African Continent.

The Health and Safety objectives are established and reviewed so that Health and Safety forms an integral part of our planning and decision making to meet the strategic direction of SARAO in conformance with the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, Act 85 Of 1993, the Regulation Legislators and the minimum requirements of the construction regulations.
