Formal tender sealed and clearly marked "TD-04/05/2022: ERECTION AND CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW CONTAINER HIVE NEXT TO THUSONG AND BONGULETHU POLICE STATION. OUDTSHOORN" must be placed in the Municipal tender box, 26 Church Street, OUDTSHOORN no later than 12:00 on 20 June 2022 and will be opened in public immediately thereafter in the Supply Chain Management Office, 26 Church Street, OUDTSHOORN or any alternative place in Oudtshoorn Municipal Offices.

A compulsory briefing session will be held at 12:00 on 02 June 2022 at the Thusong Centre, Oudtshoorn. No grace period will be allowed.

- The following COVID-19 protocol will be applicable at the briefing session:
 - Only 1 representative per tendering party
 - Pre-screening: Measuring temperature and capturing of information
 - Sanitize: Sanitizing hands before entering
 - Facial masks: All attendees to wear masks; no mask, no entry
 - Social distancing: Keep at least 1.5m apart from other attendees
- > After the compulsory briefing session, the Tendering parties may visit the Site.

A set of fully completed tender documents must be submitted on the original documents and remain valid for a maximum of 120 days after the closing date of the tender. A set of tender documents can be obtained at a non-refundable cost of R318-00 including VAT incl / or the PDF Document free of charge per email request to Ms J. Rollison. Then hard copies will be physically handed only to prospective bidders who produce a receipt for the payment of the tender document at the SCM Offices.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or re-advertise or reject any formal tender or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points. Potential bidders should note that all projects in terms of this tender may not materialize.

It is estimated that tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of 2CE or higher. Bidders must ensure that all the necessary compliance documentation is submitted with the bid at the closing date of the tender. Bidders must comply with the Formal tender conditions as stipulated in the bid document, if a bidder does not comply the bid will be regarded as non - responsive.



Formal Tenders TD-04/05/2022 will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the 80/20 Preference Point System prescribed by the Oudtshoorn Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy. Further note, it is a prerequisite that all prospective service providers who are not yet registered on the Central Supplier Database to be registered, registration can be done online via www.csd.gov.za
