LONG TERM (10-15 YEARS) INTEGRATED INVESTMENT AND TECHNICAL SOLUTION FOR ELECTRICITY AND WATER SERVICES

Proposals are hereby invited from suitably qualified Companies and Consortiums for the provision of appropriate technology and investment to assist the City of Matlosana with sustainable revenue enhancement and service delivery challenges in their electricity and water distribution networks.

The desired solution should focus on:

- Reducing technical and non-technical losses.
- Eliminating vandalism and infrastructure damage.
- Mitigating risks associated with Eskom load shedding.
- Sustaining current account arrangements with ESKOM.
- Creating additional income streams.

Key areas of interest should include investment into:

- Bulk electricity and water distribution networks.
- Sustainable Electricity generation.
- Sustainable water production.
- Debt collection.

The Municipality aims to establish a partnership that involves an off-balance sheet investment with no financial impact on the Municipality in terms of technology or capital investment, but rather focuses solely on the return on investment.

The investment methodology should be structured around the principles of a Build Operate and Transfer model.

The lowest or any bidder will not necessarily be accepted and Council reserves the right to consider any other Bid not suitably endorsed or comprehensively completed, as well as the right to accept a bid in whole or in part.
