SECTION 2: BACKGROUND, PURPOSE, AND SCOPE OF WORK


2.1 Background and/or Purpose of this Bid

The company was formed in 1993 as a public company under the Companies Act of 1973, as amended, and the Airports Company Act of 1993, as amended.



2.2 Purpose of this Bid

The purpose of this bid is to solicit a Bidder to develop (design and build) and operate (manage and maintain) a service station with a convenience store. Additional amenities are encouraged dependant on the site. The bidder has a choice of one, two or three of the locations:

- a. OR Tambo International Airport portion 187 of the Farm Witkoppie IR67 Jones Road,
- b. portion 3 of the farm Sunnyside 2620, Bloemfontein at the entrance of Bram Fischer Airport, and
- c. portion 60 of farm Gwayang 208 along R404, George at the entrance of the George Airport.

Respondents who are duly authorised, operating, and registered within South Africa are eligible to have their submissions evaluated.

2.3 Scope of Work

The scope of work details the minimum mandatory requirements expected of the Bidder by ACSA. It provides a summary of the optional amenities that may be feasible for the site which is at the discretion of the Bidder.

The Bidder will hold the blueprint for the development that is agreed upon between the Bidder and ACSA and can replicate this development if more than one site is required and awarded. The Bidder is responsible to fund the capital required for the entire development and operation. The capital estimate submission for this bid should be of a Class 2 level of definition and accuracy.

Each site will be treated as a stand-alone investment; hence the requirement is to propose a separate profit and loss statement. If the bidder is bidding for all three sites, it will, in separate cover, show the economics because of the collective investment. In such a case, the bidder's proposal will be moderated to reflect the financials of the collective investment with each site taking benefit of cost reduction (and net profit increase) in the proportion of the total revenue generated per site.

References provided will be used to confirm that the Bidder's experience (the spreadsheet is to be used to furnish ACSA with referenceable sites and contact information):

- Infrastructure developed in at least 3 provinces; and or
- Operated similar service and convenience stores establishment at a minimum of 5 sites.

- b) Calculate an estimate of the target sale volumes of ground transportation fuel together with profit.
- c) Calculate an estimate of the sales and profit from the convenience store.
- d) Calculate an estimate of the sales and profit from all other activities, if any, from the site.
- e) Calculate the expected business growth over the duration of the concession.
- f) Calculate the total infrastructure and fixtures capital that will be employed for the duration of the concession at present day values.
- g) Calculate the percent of net profit that will be payable to ACSA on an annual basis from each site.
- h) The terms of the financial mode that ACSA will enter into with the winning Bidder(s) are:
 - 1. There will be no Capex and Opex contributions from ACSA.
 - 2. Minimum guaranteed land lease that is payable per month and escalates at eight (8%) percent per annum. At the mid-point of the concession, the land lease will be reset to prevailing market conditions (through a rental reversion process). ACSA and the Bidder will enter a minimum twenty (20) year lease with renewal option not exceeding three 5-year renewals to be exercised upon agreement by the Parties. ACSA and the Bidder will further be required to enter into a tri-partite (ACSA, Developer and Operator) lease agreement binding the three parties together.
 - 3. Profit from the sales of fuel. The winning bidder will propose to ACSA the percent profit ACSA will receive from the sale of fuel at the forecourt. A minimum threshold of 10% will be applicable for all grades of fuel. Bidders with a higher percent profit allocation to ACSA will improve their prospects of being the preferred bidder.
 - 4. Convenience store and any other amenities turnover rental of one (1%) percent minimum. Bidders with a higher percent profit allocation to ACSA will improve their prospects of being the preferred bidder.

- 5. Profit proposals from additional services (e.g., Car wash, sale of LPG, courier distribution site, share-drive pick-up point) should be reflected separately and will be added to the profit-sharing proposal during the bid evaluation phase.
- 6. Proposal on the working capital required for the service station, convenience shop and drive through outlet will be evaluated on the proposed returns. This working capital shall be included as part of the Bidder's expenses and shall be included as part of the agreement to be concluded with the operator. The Bidder is required to provide the payback structure of this aspect according to their recommended standards ensuring that the operator is not prejudiced.
- 7. Working capital should be factored as part of the investment that would accrue to ACSA at the end of the concession duration.
- 8. Proposal on the capital required for the facilities will be evaluated on the proposed returns. The Bidder will fund this aspect of the development should returns demonstrated not meet a minimum after tax return of (13.5%) without any terminal value.
- Estimated capital (class 2 estimate) required for the initial investment, middle of refurbishment, and other should be stipulated in the proposal. Refer to <u>Figure 1 AACE</u> <u>Classification Standard</u> and <u>Figure 2 AACE Estimate Class</u>.
- 10. The appointment, training and ongoing management of the Operator remains the responsibility of the Bidder. Lease/s concluded will be a triple net lease.
- 11. The Bidder is to ensure that a minimum IRR after tax of (13.66%) is achieved over the lease term without including any exit or terminal value of the development costs.
- 12. Income generated by sale of projected fuel (petrol and diesel) sales volumes to be indicated separately.


