#### **C3.1 BACKGROUND**

Kouga Municipality's Local Economic Development & Tourism Section hereby invites Bids from suitably qualified and experienced contractors to supply material and undertake renovations of the Ocean View Business Support Centre

#### **C3.2 SCOPE OF WORKS**

#### Removal of existing work

- Breaking down and removing brickwork etc
- Taking out and removing doors, windows, etc from brickwork to be demolished
- Taking out and removing doors, windows, etc, including thresholds, sills, etc (building up openings and making good finishes elsewhere)
- Taking out doors, windows, etc, including thresholds, sills, etc, setting aside for re-use and later refixing in
- similar new position
- Taking down and removing roofs, floors, panelling, ceilings, partitions, etc.
- Hacking up/off and removing ceramic tiles including removing mortar bed or adhesive from concrete or brickwork and preparing surfaces for new screed, plaster, tile finish, etc

#### C3.3 GENERAL

- 3.3.1 To ensure proper standards of delivery, all tender submissions must comply with the following criteria:
- 3.3.1.1 The contractor must have a CIDB contractor's grading of 2GB or higher, and is extended to Potentially Emerging (PE) contractors one grade lower i.e. 1GB PE in the tender value range in terms of Regulation 25.(8).
- 3.3.1.2 The extent of the work to be done must be determined prior to commencing of work by inspecting all premises with the Project Manager and an agreed work schedule must be drawn up before work can start.
- 3.3.1.3 No work will be carried out by the Service Provider until such time as an official order has been issued.
- 3.3.1.4 The successful contractor shall commence with the work within ten (10) working days from receiving the official order to do so. Failure to comply with this tender condition could lead to the cancellation of the tender.
- 3.3.1.5 Penalties for late completion will be R 250.00 per day.
- 3.3.1.6 Once the work is completed the project manager and the contractor will do quality and compliance checks after which payment will be authorised. If standards were not met the contractor will be requested to re-visit the site and attend to the affected areas.
- 3.3.1.7 Provide proof of the following insurance being in place before commencement of work
  - Public Liability Insurance (R 500,000.00)
  - Professional Indemnity Insurance (R 500,000.00)
- 3.3.1.8 The work area as well as the surrounding area must be kept clean during installation of work. Rubble must be removed at regular intervals. Noise and dust levels must be kept to an absolute minimum.
- 3.3.1.9 The area of work to be occupied by the contractor, any restriction to the area and the limit of access or exit will be pointed out by the employer to the contractor on handing over of the site.
- 3.3.1.10 The Tenderer must allow in his tender for a fully qualified Site Supervisor as his representative for the <u>full duration</u> of the works.
- 3.3.1.11 The Municipality shall not be liable in respect of any claims and damages that may arise from the carrying out of this contract.
- 3.3.1.12 The Contractor must be COIDA compliant and a letter of Good Standing from the Compensation Commissioner to be submitted before commencement of work.
- 3.3.1.13 The Contractor must take all necessary precautions to ensure that he/she complies in all respects with the "Occupational Health and Safety Act (Act 85, as amended). All work shall be done in accordance with the relevant safety regulations, as amended.

3.3.1.14 All materials where not explicitly specified are to comply with the South African Bureau of Standards. If no such standards exist, all materials are further subject to being passed by inspection prior to being installed.
