1.1 DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE: SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF A NEW ULTRA-LOW FREEZER.

BACKGROUND:

Two ultra-freezers are close to full capacity and good laboratory practices require that each unit be only half full so that there is space to house the contents of the second unit, should a malfunction occur in the first and vice versa. Added to this is the ongoing expansion of the collections according to the set goals of the genebank project. A further goal of this project is the duplication of the genebank in a separate location to protect the collection in the event of the original collection being destroyed. All microbiology research projects use the various micro-organisms in the genebank and culture collection and would not be able to proceed without this vital resource.

Storage of microorganisms to preserve for future projects within the division.
