- 5.5 Respondents found to be in collusion with one another will be automatically disqualified and restricted from doing business with organs of state for a specified period.

11 SECURITY CLEARANCE

SECTION 3: BACKGROUND, OVERVIEW AND SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

BACKGROUND 1

Most of the corridor's infrastructure and equipment/machinery are more deteriorated and outdated than the plants/centres. This might be due to the lifespan of these assets since some of them were built or purchased more than 30 years ago. The infrastructure and machinery initial belong to TFR, hence their historical information when it comes to repairs and purchased year might not be accurate on TE's registers. Compressors are one of the key elements in ensuring that there is a smooth running of operations in the depots. Compressed air is one of the most used utilities in the depots as it powers almost 80% of the machines and tools. Some of these compressors have been in operation for over 15 years and have reached their useful life span. The challenge that is facing the RSM Depots is that these compressors are at the stage where it is uneconomical to repair and critical parts (crankshaft, pistol, air-ends and valve springs, etc.) are no longer easily available in the market. Some if they are urgently needed, they need to be reverse engineered and in all that we end up having no compressors

2 **EXECUTIVE OVERVIEW**

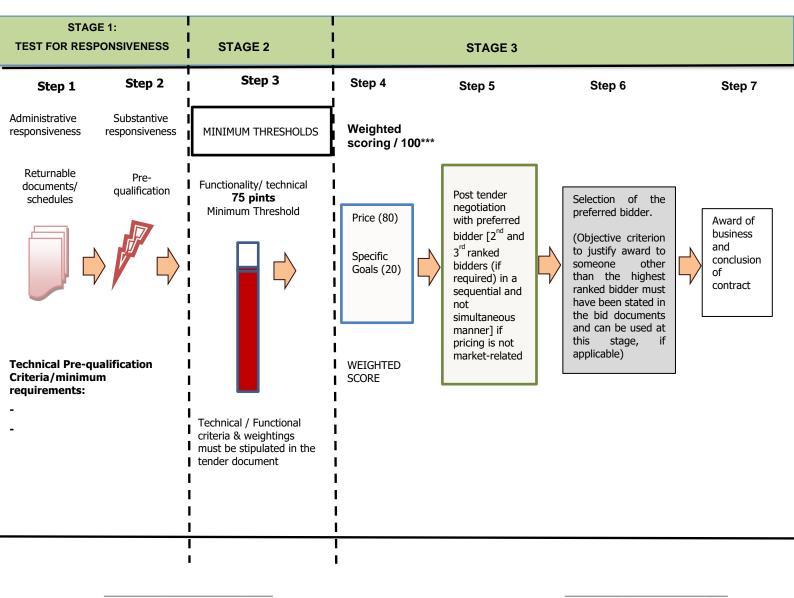

- (f) **"EME"** means an Exempted Micro Enterprise as defines by Codes of Good Practice under section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (g) **"functionality"** means the ability of a bidder to provide goods or services in accordance with specification as set out in the bid documents
- (h) "Price" includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts.
- (i) "Proof of B-BBEE Status Level of Contributor"
 - i) the B-BBBEE status level certificate issued by an authorised body or person;
 - ii) a sworn affidavit as prescribed by the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice; or
 - iii) any other requirement prescribed in terms of the B-BBEE Act.
- (j) "QSE" means a Qualifying Small Enterprise as defines by Codes of Good Practice under section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (k) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties.

3. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

3.1 THE 80/20 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 points is allocated for price on the following basis:
