

## PRICING SCHEDULE

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## 1.1 Pricing *Assumptions*

### **For Rigging and Crane Hire:**

- 1) The price reflected below must be fixed and firm. Failure to provide a fixed and firm price will declare the tender non responsive.
- 2) The price must be rates in Rand, Exclusive of Vat.
- 3) Invoicing and payment will be done monthly on all work completed in the previous months.
- 4) The price must be for the full scope and include all requirements.
- 5) Rates contained in this schedule shall include the following:
  - 5.1 Call out costs
  - 5.2 Transportation costs to and from site
  - 5.3 Cost for the use of rigging equipment
  - 5.4 Rigging studies and other rigging service costs
  - 5.5 And any other item of expense that is necessary for the completion of the scope
- 6) As the contractor will likely need to pay their employees minimum rates for each job (e.g. 4 hours as per the department of labour); Transnet has allowed for this by using the minimum invoice amount.
- 7) Cost for crane driver must be included on the crane hire cost.
