The uMgungundlovu District Municipality seeks professional service providers to form a panel of contractors for Water and Sanitation Construction Projects. The uMgungundlovu District Municipality as the Water Services Authority will be embarking on extensive grant funded Water and Sanitation Infrastructure Construction Projects for the period of 3 years.

If tenders are collected, a non-refundable tender deposit of R150.00 is payable to the uMgungundlovu District Municipality. Tender submissions must be properly bound and must be placed in the tender box situated on the ground floor of the uMgungundlovu District Municipality, 242 Langalibalele Street, Pietermaritzburg, before **12h00 on 13 December 2023 for CIDB designation of 6CE and 7CE**, in a sealed envelope which is clearly marked with the Tender Number and Tender Description. Late quotations or Tenders received by way of Facsimile or E-Mail will under no circumstances be considered.

All eligibility criteria must be furnished accordingly, where mandatory or applicable. Tenderers will thereafter be evaluated in terms of functionality. Tenderers that qualified in terms of the functionality criteria will then be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference point system as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022.

Only tenderers who are registered with the CIDB or are capable of being registered prior to the close of this tender, in a contractor grading equal to a 6CE and 7CE will be eligible to tender.

Tenderers must submit a minimum of two (2) written reference letters together with appointment letters and completion certificates of work of a similar nature i.e. Water & Sanitation Infrastructure Projects), awarded within the past 8 years with a minimum value of:

>R 10,000,000.00 per project for a bidder with a CIDB designation of 6CE and

>R 20,000,000.00 per project for a bidder with a CIDB designation of 7CE.

Attach Latest Financial Statements for the past three years; or since their establishment if established during the past three years.

Tenderers will be evaluated in terms of functionality as part of the minimum requirements before evaluated on price and preference based on the following criteria:

2.Human Resources - Contract Manager: (a) CV Qualifications showing the Number of Years in Water/Sanitation Infrastructure Projects (b) Technical Qualifications	20 Points
3.Human Resources - Site Agent: Experience in Water/Sanitation Infrastructure related Projects	20 Points
4.Experience of Tenderer Bidders must attach their company registration document to validate the total number of years the company/firm has been in the industry/business/existence/operation	20 points
5.Financial Resources - Bank Rating (A-D) Prospective Bidders to provide proof of their capacity to undertake this project - Points will be only allocated if a valid Bank Rating Letter from the Entity's Financial Institution (Bank) is attached	20 Points
Total Functionality Points	100 Points

A bidder/s that scores less than 70 points out of 100 in respect of functionality will be regarded as submitting a non-responsive bid and will be disqualified.

The 80/20 preference point system in terms of the municipality's SCM Policy will be applicable as follows:
