INTRODUCTION

The South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA) is a public entity listed in Schedule 3 (A) of the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA). SAQA oversees the further development and implementation of the National Qualifications Framework (NQF) and ensures the achievement of its objectives.

PURPOSE

SAQA will be hosting a formal lunch to bid farewell to its retiring CEO and welcome the incoming CEO. The purpose of this Request for Quotation (RFQ) is to appoint a suitably qualified service provider to transport staff members from SAQA House, 1067 Arcadia Street, to Hotel Sky, Sandton, Johannesburg and back. The event is scheduled to begin at 12:00 and end at 15:00. There are **67 staff members** which need to be picked up from SAQA House to the venue and back.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The bid will be evaluated on one (1) stage:

Stage 1: Price evaluation (Price (80%) and B-BBEE (20%) in line with the PPPFA)

QUOTATION REQUIREMENTS

The quotation must include:

- 1. Service providers should include their travelling cost in the quotation to and from the venue
- 2. All cost must be VAT inclusive
- Valid Driver's licenses and PDP
- 4. Please quote on transport that can accommodate more than 10 people at a time.
- 5. Recent CSD report.

NB: Bidders must clearly indicate on their quotations/cost estimates how they arrived at the price they propose to charge for this project.


