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Title: **Scope of work and Technical Evaluation Criteria for Cadastral Survey Services**

1. Scope of work

1.1 To perform Cadastral Surveys, on behalf of Eskom, in terms of the Geomatics Profession Act 19 of 2013 (previously Land Survey Act 8 of 1997), which will include:

- 1.1.1 Registration Surveys of Linear Infrastructure servitudes (e.g. Power lines, Cable routes and access roads). Rates are based on a Standard table, calculating number of bend points and leg lengths as per the South African Geomatics Council;
- 1.1.2 Registration surveys of site servitudes (e.g. Substation, CNC and Radio Repeater sites) Rates are based on a the area and number of corner beacons, using a standard table as per South African Geomatics Council;
- 1.1.3 Consolidation, Sub-divisions and Amendments survey and registration. Rates are based on a the area and number of corner beacons, using a standard table as per South African Geomatics Council;
- 1.1.4 Relocation and verification of Cadastral Boundaries and Beacons. Rate per hour and per beacon ;
- 1.1.5 Demarcation of Servitude boundaries. Rate per hour and per beacon;
- 1.1.6 Cadastral Compilations. Rate per hour;
- 1.1.7 Surveyor General Diagram Auditing. Rate per hour;
- 1.1.8 Professional Consultation. Rate per hour;
- 1.1.9 SPLUMA Applications. Rate per hour and per application;

2. Evaluation Criteria

The evaluation criteria and corresponding weightings as set out in the enquiry should be as follows:

Step 1: Basic Compliance

Submissions will be reviewed for compliance with all submission requirements to ensure that mandatory requirements are met. This will be conducted at both pre-qualification phase and RFQ phase. Commercial evaluation does not carry a weighting at both phases.

Step 2: Functional Analysis (Technical)

Proof of Registration as a Professional Land Surveyor / Geomatics Professional with South African Geomatics Council (SAGC) is mandatory, failure to proof such will lead to disqualification. See table below for the technical weightings.

3. Equipment: Electronic Total Station	20
4. Survey Software	15
5. Minimum one (1) LDV	15

Tenderers to submit the proof of ownership in the name of the tendering company. In the case of sole proprietor the proof of ownership in the name of owner is acceptable

Final points for technical evaluation criteria Items 2-4 above will only be allocated after inspection/ evaluation. Site inspection will only be conducted on the suppliers that meet the desktop qualification threshold. The tools and equipment should be available on site for the inspection which will be conducted by Eskom representatives at the Supplier's Business premises and failure which the tenderers will be disqualified from further evaluations.

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
