#### 5 LATE BIDS

- 5.1 Bids received late shall not be considered. A bid will be considered late if it arrived even one second after 11:00 or any time thereafter. ## **TERMS OF REFERENCE (TOR)**

#### 1. PURPOSE

The National Electronic Media Institute of South Africa (NEMISA) hereby invites experienced and suitably qualified service providers to submit bids for the provision of Online learning content Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) that provide training for skilling, upskilling and reskilling in Emerging Technology courses that are internationally recognised and, as well as specialist credentialed courses from industry leaders and experts.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

NEMISA is a training provider in creative media and digital skills. Recently, the mandate was expanded to include Emerging Technologies for South African citizens. The organisation seeks to acquire internationally recognized online learning content that can be used to train South African citizens through the NEMISA In-House Online Learning Platform.

#### 3. CONTRACT PERIOD

Period of 24 Months.

#### 4. SCOPE OF WORK

NEMISA is looking for a partner to provide online learning content (MOOCs) that is relevant to the skilling, upskilling, and reskilling of South African citizens, particularly in the fields of ICT and Emerging Technologies (Data Science, AI, Business and Creative Media) both technical skills and soft skills.

#### 5. FUNCTIONALITIES

The functionalities must include but not be limited to:

- The provider of the learning content must be able to provide a large variety of completed, tested and proven online learning courses (MOOCs)
- Courses must be internationally recognised. (Provided and created by well know, acclaimed, and recognised Universities, with a cultural spread, i.e. Not only from one country or internationally certified industry professionals)

- Course providers should be theoretical (academic). However, they should also include content from ICT industry leaders and experts in cutting-edge topics like IT Support, Cloud, Data Science, Cyber Security. (Global leading technology companies)
- Content must be available directly from the provider without accessing third-party sites.
- Already completed courses should provide options for subtitles in one or more official South African Languages. (Zulu, Xhosa, Southern Sotho, Afrikaans or Tswana – at least two languages must exist currently be ready for use)
- Courses should include assessments, labs and projects that provide deep skilling that allows NEMISA to verify that learning have taken place.
- Course access or 'seats' should be exchangeable between course participants without prior notice or consent from the supplier. Exchanges should be at NEMISA's discretion.
- There should be an option for courses to be combined into learning paths providing Job Skills. A full learning plan should provide a complete job description. (Industry-led qualifications or University lead qualifications that provide practical skills)
- The service provider should provide guided projects and courses that speak to NEMISA's mandate: Digital Literacy, SMME Training, Emerging Technologies, and Creative Media.
- At least 2 000 (two thousand) revolving sets/licenses.

#### 6. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- The learning content provider should have experience running courses accessed by upward of 50 000 students.
- The learning content provider must have extensive experience running national-scale public sector programs. (Provide at least 10 countries with results)
- The provider should allow NEMISA to easily create projects that, if needed, can be hosted on the provider learning portal under a NEMISA branded sub-portal and connected to the NEMISA Digital Skills Platform via an SSO. (There should also be functionality for African language subtitles)
- Projects should incorporate virtual machine functionality so learners do not need to purchase or download additional software.
- NEMISA should be able to access an analytics dashboard that allows category or program admins and site admins, to measure and report on the following:
  - Learner progression through courses and programs.
  - · View learner satisfaction with courses,
  - monitor utilisation changes,
  - track skill building across detailed domains,
    - Communicate with and motivate learners using pre-set and custom templates targeted at common program barriers.

- NEMISA should be able to create various sub-program groups that can be allocated specific content and administrated by NEMISA Partner administrators with limited admin capacity.
- Weekly reports should be sent to NEMISA, tracking student registration and progress
- The service provider should be able to provide specific scientifically and statistically backed advice on skills needed for different sectors and which courses speak to the various skills.
- The service provider should offer a skill advisory support system with a dedicated content advisory team, which can pull data from global learners into essential skill maps across industries (Skill maps must have verifiable statistical backing)
- The service provider will provide a dedicated account manager to liaise with the NEMISA team from time to time and be available for questions and requests.
- Cobranded verifiable badges should be available for special career course projects.
- The service provider should provide support for benchmarking NEMISA's and South Africa's competitiveness against global leaders and regional competitors. (Verifiable, Scientific and statistical backing)
- The service provider should be able to assist in creating the API for the SSO integration with the NEMISA DSP.
- Badges and or Certificates issued to students should be Cobranded.

Language: The language to be used on the main site is English (with some course subtitles in at least two African Languages)

User Interface: Menu-driven interface compatible with all browsers for mobile devices, tablets, and computers (any OS) – the user experience to be the same way on mobile phones as on their laptops.

#### 7.UPDATES

All courses need to be kept up to date with regular data improvements. The appointed service provider will give NEMISA 7 days' notice before taking the site offline for maintenance or updates.

#### 8.AUDIENCE

The target audience for the NEMISA LMS and its course content includes but is not limited to:

- o Current and prospective students
- o NEMISA Board and employees
- o The shareholder (Department of Communications and Digital Technologies) o Industry associations

#### 9.TRAINING

Provide adequate training to NEMISA employees (LMS) to efficiently operate, update. /Upload information, manage the interaction between the NEMISA Learning platform and the provider's platform, and manage NEMISA data on the service provider's platform after its implementation. Provide a dedicated service team to assist NEMISA with projects, queries, and promotions—biweekly meetings with the NEMISA team.

1.3.2 The score for functionality shall be calculated as follow
---

- ☐ Each panel member shall award values for each individual criterion on a score sheet. The value scored for each criterion shall be multiplied with the specified weighting for the relevant criterion to obtain the marks scored for the various criteria. These marks should be added to obtain the total score for functionality.
- ☐ The score of each panel member shall be added together and divided by the number of panel members to establish the average score obtained by each individual bidder for functionality.

#### 1.4 DETERMINATION OF SCORE FOR PRESENTATIONS

1.4.1 NEMISA will not call for presentations.

OR

- 1.4.2 NEMISA has decided/may decide to have compulsory presentations made either by all bidders who have obtained at least 80% of the marks for functionality, or by the bidders ranked first to a maximum of six, but not less than the three highest scoring bidders once the price and preference marks have been combined.
- 1.4.3 Presentations shall only affect the marks awarded for functionality. If NEMISA wishes to use presentations to discriminate between bidders, the evaluation criteria to be affected shall be determined in advance and due allowance made in the mark scheme and indicated in paragraph 1.2.1.
- 1.4.4 Points determined by the presentation will be awarded to each bidder by each member of the Bid Evaluation Committee and then an average calculated. Such score will be added to the original score for functionality.
- 1.4.5 A bidder will be disqualified if the combined score for functionality fails to meet the minimum threshold for functionality as per paragraph 1.341.

#### 1.5 ELIMINATION OF PROPOSALS ON GROUNDS OF FUNCTIONALITY

1.5.1 Bids that score less than **80%** of the marks available for functionality will be eliminated from further consideration. Marks will therefore not be awarded for their cost proposals or for preference.

#### 1.6 PRICE AND B-BBEE STATUS LEVEL POINTS

- 1.6.1 All remaining bids will be evaluated as follows:
- 1.6.2 The 80/20 preference point system will be applied. Points for price and B-BBEE status level certificate will be awarded in accordance with the stipulations in the Preference Point Claim Form in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017.
- 1.6.3 If appropriate, implied contract price adjustments will be made to the cost proposals of all remaining bids.

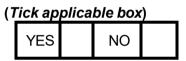
